Bonneville School District 93 Leadership Premiums 2020-2021

- Each school will receive funds for Leadership Premiums based on their calculated certified FTE positions
- School Leadership Teams will develop a plan to allocate Leadership Premiums within the following guidelines:
 - The minimum amount for a position will be \$400
 - The maximum amount for a position will be \$2,000
 - School plans must include the following leadership positions
 - School Leadership Team (minimum of 3 positions)
 - Leadership Team members may be assigned to champion roles
 - Leadership Team members may be assigned to RTI roles (minimum of 1 positions)
 - Testing Coordinators (secondary only - 1 position)
- Schools will submit Leadership Premium Plans to the Human Resource Department by October 1, 2021 for approval.
- Leadership premiums will continue to be set aside for CTE and PPS Hard-to-Fill positions and for the mentoring program.
- School allocations will be based on 62.5% of the schools FTE.

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Instructions for Medication Log

- 1) A separate medication sheet is required for each medication prescribed.
- 2) Full signature is required on page one (1) of medication log with initials after signature.
- 3) If student does not receive the full dosage of medication write the date, time and reason on the back of the medication log, including your signature.
- 4) All entries must be in Blue or Black Ink.
- 5) Initial and date after giving any medication. Must have a second set of initials to verify count is correct. If count is not correct, must notify district nurse immediately.
- 6) If medication is administered twice during the day, divide the calendar for initials. If medication is administered more than two times per day, then use a different log for each dose and write on top of log the time this dose-page is for.
- 7) If a writing error is made on medication log, draw a line through the error and initial.
- 8) If a physician/dentist changes a dose, physician/dentist, parents/guardians and principal must sign a new request for medication.
- 9) All medication vials/bottles/etc. must be labeled with student name, medication name, dosage, method, and time of day to be taken.
- 10) If a dose is missed for any reason (see above key code), please place the code in the calendar with initials. If student refuses to take the medicine or does not show, parents/guardians must be notified.
