3.1 First Student Presentation

HAT President Jessica McCann provided a union update, welcoming new officers and staff and working with the board this school year.

6 REPORTS

6.1 Board of Education

The Board members shared of events and activities in which they participated or attended since the last Board meeting, highlighting community bond project construction, Umatilla County Fair volunteer and student efforts, the Oregon School Boards Association summer conference, the new staff breakfast, the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada's (GFOA) Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting award, the start of the school year and athletic practices.

6.2 Business Office

Ms. Saul explained the consent agenda items with a brief overview.

6.2.1 Financial Reports

Ms. Saul provided projection reports for the upcoming fiscal year and explained how the numbers are calculated. The projections yield a 12.34% ending fund balance.

Dr. Farley compared traditional and standards-based grading and the involvement of parents to help students achieve. He continued by explaining the principles of standards-based grading and addressing special education grading.

Dr. Farley provided further explanation and answered questions of the board members.

7.2 English Learnings in Oregon State Report

Elementary Education Director Dr. Jerad Farley and Secondary Education Director Scott Depew presented the Oregon State English Learner Report, for the 2021-22 school year. Mr. Depew explained the EL identification and shared Oregon EL student statistics. The team then compared to HSD statistics to the state.

Dr. Farley reviewed SLIFE (students with limited or interrupted education) prevalence and its profile in Oregon.

The directors made the statistics practical and related it to attendance and grade rates. They concluded by looking forward, reviewing ELD priorities for elementary and secondary students.

Dr. Mooney provided the board with hardcopy documents outlining pay-to-play fees and tuition rates with associated ORS's identified and text provided.

Pursuant to ORS 279B.080, and in accordance with OAR 137-049-0150, the Hermiston School District has declared an emergency bidding exemption situation as a result of a failed water heater at Desert View Elementary School. Immediate and prompt action must be taken to ensure the continuation of educational services for staff and students.

As outlined in associated Oregon rules, a contracting agency may declare that emergency circumstances exist that require prompt execution of a public contract for emergency construction or repair work. This declaration has been made at an administrative level consistent with the contracting agency's internal policies (DJC), by this written declaration that describes the circumstances creating the emergency, and the anticipated harm from failure to enter into an emergency contract.

The District, in its emergency proposal, will require the contracting firm to comply with the applicable wage rate and hour laws.

This emergency declaration shall be kept on file as a public record.


