1. CALL TO ORDER – Chair Shields

Chair Shields called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

1. 1. Adoption of Agenda for February 26, 2020

Chair Shields called for a motion to adopt the agenda for the meeting. Director Butenschoen moved and Director Boettcher seconded the motion.

The motion was approved by the following Directors: Boettcher, Butenschoen, Chhetri, Etherly, Hardin, Schroeder and Shields. Director Schroeder was absent.

3. 1. Board Meeting Minutes from February 12, 2020

Chair Shields called for a motion to approve the minutes for the February 12, 2020 meeting. Director Boettcher moved and Director Hardin seconded the motion.

The motion was approved by the following Directors: Boettcher, Butenschoen, Chhetri, Etherly, Hardin, Schroeder and Shields. Director Schroeder was absent.

4. PUBLIC FORUM

Chair Shields read a proclamation acknowledging March 2-6, 2020 as Classified Employees Appreciation Week in the Centennial School District.

5. REPORTS

5.1. Parklane Elementary School Report - Jorge Meza, Principal

Chair Shields recognized Mr. Meza. Mr. Meza asked Parklane staff members in attendance to introduce themselves.

Principal Meza shared his school's mission, vision and how they tie to the district's strategic plan – Destination 2023.

During his 25-minute presentation, Mr. Meza shared a great deal of demographic and academic achievement data.

Parklane's student racial breakdown data is as follows: Hispanic – 34%, White – 31%, African American – 12%, Asian – 11%, Pacific Islander – 4%. The fastest growing group of students at Parklane is the Hispanic population. A total of 25 languages are spoken at Parklane.

With regard to the Smarter Balance assessments, overall Parklane did not see the kinds of gains Mr. Meza would have liked but there were pockets of growth in Math and Reading including fluency in 3rd through 6th grade.

Hispanic students are showing the fastest academic growth overall.

Parklane's Kindergarten students are showing the highest level of growth across the entire district, with 56 percent at or above grade level.

Principal Meza said his school continues to align curriculum, instruction and assessments to data, and are bringing in culturally relevant high impact instructional strategies.

With regard to student behavior, Mr. Meza said there are a small number of students who have MTSS Tier I needs. His school's staff is working to meet every student's needs in a way that is comprehensive.

Assistant Principal, Mike Sauers stated that there has been a massive reduction in major referrals although there still some racial groups that are overrepresented. His staff is constantly working to respond in a culturally relevant way to diminish the number of major referrals.

Mr. Meza said that chronic absenteeism has declined dramatically at his school due to home visits, and an overall approach of reaching out to families with the attitude of caring, not penalizing.

Parklane's principal also stated that the school's community partners have played a critical role in making the school a welcoming place for students and families. Those partners have provided dental and health care, as well as important information to improve the quality of life for families.

Following the presentation, Directors Chhetri, Butenschoen and Boettcher asked questions regarding student mobility, and improving test scores for specific groups of students.

Dr. Coakley praised Mr. Meza for his leadership and the positive momentum with regard to attendance, academic growth and behavioral referral drops. He was particularly pleased with home visits and other efforts to reach out to students and families.

Following the presentation, Chair Shields called for a short break at 7:23 p.m.

After a ten-minute break, Chair Shields called the meeting to order, and pointed out an agenda change. A representative from the district's auditor, Pauley Rogers was present to review the results of the audit.

Chief Executive Officer of Business and Operations, Cheryl Wangeman introduced Raishell Everett, who gave the board a short review of the audit.

Ms. Everett stated that there were no major areas of concern with regard to CSD's audit.

The three issues she highlighted were:

- One incident of a purchase made without getting three bids before purchase. This was highly unusual, and a sufficient explanation was given for this.
- The level of insurance the district carries. Ms. Everett said no districts carry the ideal level of insurance due to the extremely high cost.
- A need for a higher level of password protections when accessing financial software. Ms. Wangeman assured the board that this has been corrected.

5. 2. Superintendent's Report - Dr. Coakley

Superintendent Coakley shared the updated bond website - www.csdbond2020.com

Dr. Coakley made two bond presentations, one at the high school and a second at the middle school. By sharing the bond information with large groups of staff, he believes it prevents misinformation and hopefully builds support for its passage. He also plans on giving the presentation at the Classified Employee Appreciation Breakfast next Wednesday.

Last Friday US Congressman Earl Blumenauer spoke to AP and General Government students at the high school. During his presentation he talked about what's happening in the news and answered a number of questions from students. Mr. Blumenauer then met with Dr. Coakley and it was an overall positive visit.

The superintendent also told the board that Centennial Middle School Assistant Principal Gayle Imran-Sideris has been selected as Principal at Butler Creek Elementary school for the 2020-2021 school year. Mrs. Imran-Sideris will attend the next board meeting to be officially introduced as the incoming principal.

Following the Superintendent's Report Chair Shields called for a break at 7:50 p.m.

Chair Shields resumed the meeting at 7:55 p.m.
