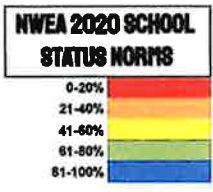

**Secondary Principal Report
November 2021 – School Board Meeting**

I. Senior Spotlight

- A. The Banner Press highlights seniors from around the area. So far this school year, two seniors have been chosen as Senior Spotlight Students. Our two seniors are Michael Janak & Lanae Aerts. There will be future East Butler Seniors who will be chosen to represent our school in the coming months.

II. ASVAB Test – Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery

- A. All East Butler Juniors took the ASVAB Test on October 26th.
- B. The ASVAB test helps the Department of Defense determine if a student is a good fit for the military. The test will also tell students which branch of the military that they would be most successful in joining.

III. ESU 7 Principal Cluster

- A. On October 26th, Mr. Biltoft & Mr. Cidlik attended a Principal Cluster training hosted by ESU 7. Dr. David Du Jong of the University of South Dakota presented simulations of problems that principals have to deal with on a daily basis. As Principals, we discussed the different decisions that we can make and how this can impact our school. Mr. Biltoft & Mr. Cidlik presented on creating a walkthrough and formal evaluation tool since we have adopted the Danielson Instructional Model. We also discussed the timeline that our school is on for full implementation of the evaluation tools.

IV. Professional Learning Day

- A. On Monday, November 1st, our staff engaged in a professional learning day. The main part of our time was spent on a data dig presented by ESU 7 staff members Mark Brady & Laura Plas. Our staff was split into groups of three to investigate our own student's test scores. The data dig helped our staff understand where our students scored high and where they scored low.
- B. CPR Training occurred for the staff members who needed to fulfill that requirement.

V. Paraeducator Walkthroughs

- A. To become more active in helping our paraeducators Mr. Cidlik has started completing walkthrough observations on the secondary paraeducators. The walkthrough looks at 5 areas – Support an environment of respect and rapport, manage classroom behaviors, manage classroom procedures, communication, & assist in student learning.
- B. During the walkthrough observation, Mr. Cidlik will document observable areas and share the information with the paraeducator. This will provide evidence of paraeducator effectiveness and help with the formal evaluation process at the end of the school year.
