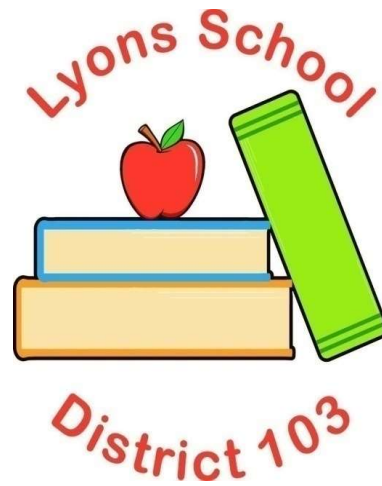

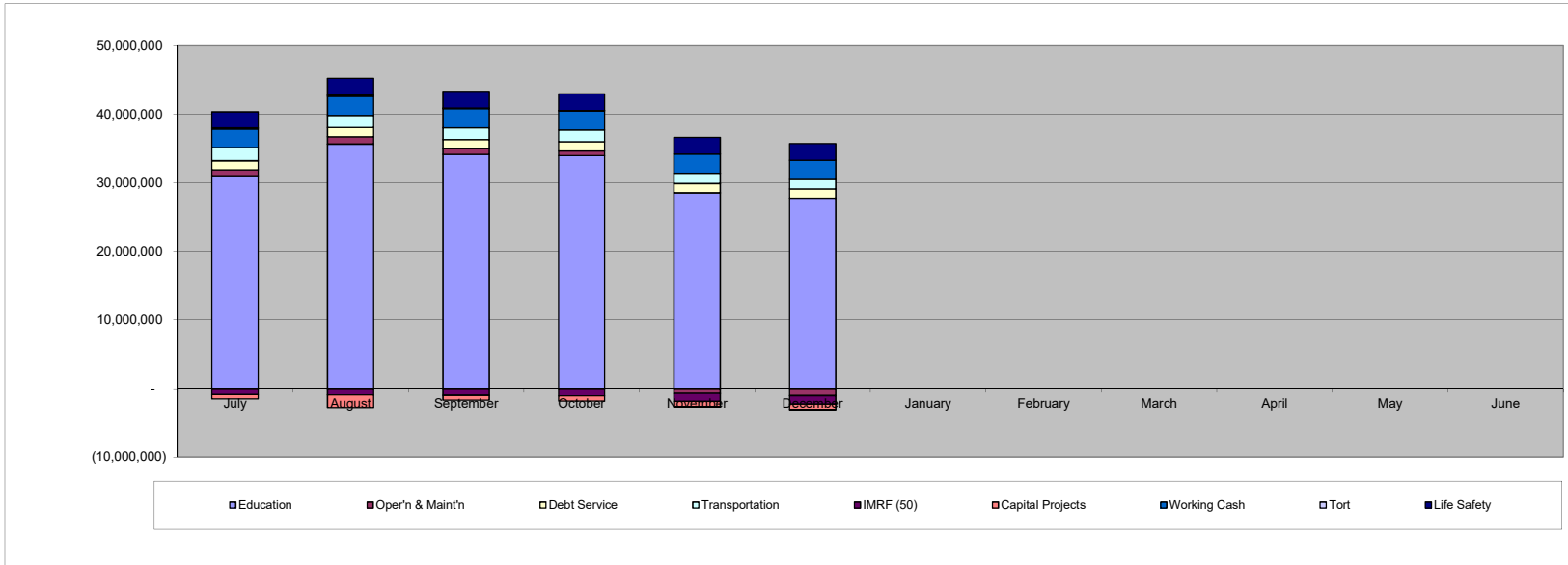

Presentation of Proposed Tax Levy

Kadir Dada presented the Board with an overview slide presentation of the proposed tax levy for 2024. He stated that school funding is based primarily on local property value. Mr. Dada informed the Board that the CPI for 2024 is 3.4%. He stated the total levy request this year is an increase of 6.95% from last year and that the reason for the increase is due to not increasing last year's levy. Mr. Dada stated a school district's levy will change each year based on CPI; new property; and any changes to the district's annual debt schedule. He briefly reviewed the CPI history in the district. Mr. Dada informed the Board that there is a 73.29% fund balance, which is healthy. He stated there will be some capital projects in the amount of \$3,000,000 over the next ten years. Mr. Dada informed the Board that the total of all fund balances is \$29,203,826. He also stated that if we get the property relief grant in the requested amount of \$2,314,076 that it will require an abatement. Mr. Dada stated we will receive notification of the status of the grant in March, 2025. He stated the Board will also need to take action to abate the required levy. Mr. Dada went over the timeline of the levy calendar.

The Board had a brief discussion regarding the levy.

OF LYONS SCHOOL DISTRICT 103 EDUCATION

**ARTICLE I
OFFICES, CORPORATE SEAL**

Section 1.01. Registered Office. The registered office of the corporation in Illinois shall be that set forth, in the Articles of Incorporation, or in a resolution of the Directors filed with the Secretary of State changing the registered office.

Section 1.02. Other Offices. The corporation may have such other offices, within or without the State of Illinois, as the Directors shall from time to time determine.

Section 103. Corporate Seal. The corporation may have a corporate seal of a design and form to be determined by the Board of Directors.

**ARTICLE II
BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

Section 2.01 Members. This Foundation shall have no members. All corporate actions shall be approved by the Board of Directors as provided in these bylaws. All rights which would otherwise rest in the members shall rest in the Directors.

Section 2.02. General Powers. The property, affairs and business of the corporation shall be managed by the Directors.

Section 2.03. Property. No Director shall have any right title or Interest in or to the property of the corporation.

Section 2.04. Number, Qualification and Term of Office. The number of Directors shall be a minimum number of five (5) and not more than nine (9), however, the number of voting Directors may be increased or decreased to any odd number, by amendment of these bylaws. All Directors shall be appointed by those remaining duly qualified Directors. The Superintendent of Schools or designee and a member of the Board of Education as chosen by that body shall hold permanent official seats with vote. Each appointed Director shall hold office until the annual meeting three (3) years following his or her election and until a successor is elected, or until his or her death, or until resignation, or until he or she is removed in the manner hereinafter provided. Each permanent Director shall hold office until his or her designated position with the School District is changed. The initial appointed Directors shall draw lots for initial terms of office. The term of office for approximately one-third of the appointed Directors shall expire each year. Appointed Directors may be re-elected to successive terms.

Section 2.05. Resignation. Any Directors of the corporation may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Chairman of the Board or to the Secretary of the corporation. The resignation of any Director shall take effect at the time specified therein; and, unless otherwise specified therein, the acceptance of such resignation shall not be necessary to make it effective.

Section 2.06. Vacancies. Any vacancy in the appointed Board of Directors caused by death, resignation, disqualification, removal, or any other cause, shall be filled by a majority vote of the remaining Directors and the Director so elected shall hold office for the remaining term of that Directorship or until his or her successor shall be duly elected and qualified by the remaining Directors. Any vacancy in permanent Directors as noted in Section 2.04 shall be filled when the designated position with the School District has been determined.

Section 2.07. Place of Meeting. The Board of Directors may hold its meetings at such place or places, within or without of the State of Illinois, as it may choose.

Section 2.08. Annual Meeting. As soon as practical and not more than sixty (60) days after the beginning of a new fiscal year the annual meeting of the corporation shall be held for the purpose of election of officers of the corporation and any other business or transactions as shall come before the meeting. Notice of the annual meeting shall be given in writing not less than ten (10) days prior to said meeting date.

Section 2.09. Regular Meetings. Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held at such time and place within the State of Illinois as the Board may determine by resolution adopted by a majority of the whole Board of Directors. Notice of regular meetings shall be given five (5) days prior to the meeting.

Section 2.10. Special Meetings; Notice. Special meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held whenever called by the Chairman of the Board or by one-third (1/3) of the total number of Directors. Notice of each such special meeting, except in cases of emergency, shall be mailed to each Director, addressed to the Director at his or her residence or usual place of business, at least five (5) days before the day on which the meeting is to be held, or to be delivered personally or by telephone, no later than two (2) days before the day on which the meeting is to be held. Each such notice shall state the time and place of the meeting. Any meeting of the Board shall be a legal meeting without any notice thereof having been given, if all of the Directors of the corporation then in office shall be present thereat (except where a Director attends a meeting for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of any business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened) or waive such notice in writing before, at, or after such meeting.

Section 2.11. Quorum and Manner of Acting. Except as otherwise provided by statute or by these Bylaws, a minimum of 51% of the Directors shall be required to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting, and the act of a majority of the Directors present at any meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board of Directors. In the absence of a quorum, a majority of the Directors present may adjourn any meeting until a quorum be had. Notice of any adjourned meeting need not be given.

Section 2.12. Removal of Directors. All Directors of the Lyons School District 103 Education Foundation must attend 50% of the monthly regular scheduled Board meetings during a fiscal year. Any Director with the exception of the permanent seats, as outlined in Section 2.04 of these bylaws, may be removed with or without cause at any time. Removal shall be by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the total number of Directors of the corporation at a special meeting of the Directors called for that purpose. Written notice stating the place, date, hour, and purpose of any special meeting called for the purpose of removing one or more Directors must be delivered to all Directors at least twenty (20) days prior to such meeting. If mailed, the notice of a meeting shall be deemed delivered when deposited in the United States mail addressed to the Director at his or her address as it appears on the records of the corporation, with postage thereon prepaid. The vacancy in the Board of Directors caused by any such removal shall be filled in the manner specified in Section 2.06 hereof.

Section 2.13. Proxies. Proxies will be allowed.

ARTICLE III OFFICERS

Section 3.01. Number. The officers of the corporation shall be a Chairman of the Board, a Vice Chairman, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and other officers as may be appointed by the Board of Directors. Any two (2) or more offices, except those of Chairman of the Board and Vice Chairman, may be held by the same person.

Section 3.02. Election, Term of Office and Qualifications. All officers shall be elected annually by the Directors of the corporation with a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the total number of Directors, except in the case of Officers appointed in accordance with the provisions of Section 3.10, each shall hold office for a period of one (1) year and until his or her successor shall have been duly elected and qualified, or until his or her death, or until he or she shall resign, or until he or she shall have been removed in the manner hereinafter provided. Officers shall be Directors.

Section 3.03. Resignation. Any officer may resign at any time by giving written notice of his or her resignation to the Board of Directors, to the Chairman of the Board or to the Secretary of the corporation. Any such resignation shall take effect at the time specified therein; and, unless otherwise specified therein, the acceptance of such resignation shall not be necessary to make it effective.

Section 3.04. Election and Removal. Election of an officer shall not of itself create contract rights. Any officer elected by the Board of Directors may be removed by the Board with a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the total number of Directors whenever in its judgment the best interests of the corporation would be served thereby. Such removal shall be without prejudice to the contract rights, if any, of the person so removed.

Section 3.05. Vacancies. A vacancy in any office because of death, resignation, removal or any other cause shall be filled for the unexpired portion of the term in the manner prescribed in these Bylaws for election or appointment to such office.

Section 3.06. Chairman of the Board. The Chairman of the Board may be an employee, Director, agent or member of the Board of Education of Lyons School District 103. The Chairman of the Board shall assume all duties normally associated with that office. The Chairman of the Board shall conduct the meetings of the corporation. The Chairman of the Board shall be the chief executive officer of the corporation and shall have general active management of the business of the corporation. He or she, shall, when present, preside at all meetings of the Directors. He or she shall see that all orders and resolutions of the Board of Directors are carried into effect. He or she, with the proper signature of one other duly qualified officer of the corporation may, upon the approval of the Board of Directors, execute and deliver in the name of the corporation any deeds, mortgages, bonds, contracts or other instruments pertaining to the business of the corporation, including without limitation, any instruments necessary or appropriate to enable the corporation to donate income or principal of the corporation to or for the account of such organizations, causes, and projects described in the Articles of Incorporation of the corporation as the corporation was organized to support. He or she shall have such other duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Board of Directors.

Section 3.07. Vice Chairman. A Vice-Chair, shall be elected by the Board of Directors, shall have such powers and shall perform such duties as may be specified in the Bylaws or prescribed by the Board of Directors or by the Chairman of the Board. In the event of absence or disability of the Chairman of the Board, the Vice-Chair shall succeed to his or her power and duties in the order designated by the Board of Directors.

Section 3.08. Secretary. The Secretary or designee shall see that the proceedings of the meetings of the Board of Directors are kept. He or she shall when directed to do so, notify the Directors of all meetings, and perform such other duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Board of Directors or by the Chairman of the Board and, in general shall perform all duties incident to the office of the Secretary.

Section 3.09. Treasurer. The Treasurer shall cause to be kept accurate accounts of all moneys of the corporation received or disbursed. He or she shall deposit all moneys, drafts and checks in the name of, and to the credit of, the corporation in such banks and depositories as a majority of the whole Board of Directors, by resolution, shall from time to time designate. He or she shall have power to endorse for deposit all notes, checks and drafts received by the corporation. He or she shall cause to be rendered to the Chairman of the Board and the Directors, wherever required, an account of all his or her transactions as Treasurer and of the financial condition of the corporation, and shall perform such other duties as may from time to time be prescribed by the Board of Directors or by the Chairman of the Board, and, in general, shall perform all duties incident to the office of the Treasurer.

Section 3.10. Other Officers. The corporation may have such other officers and agents as may be deemed necessary by the Board of Directors, who shall be appointed in such manner, have such duties and hold their offices for such terms as may be determined by resolution of the Board of Directors.

Section 3.11. Directors. The Board of Directors may establish a body of Directors to assist and advise in the development and operation of the Foundation. The Directors may be appointed by the Board of Directors in any number the Directors may from time to time deem necessary. The Directors shall have no vote in foundation matters, no authority to affect foundation policy and may not act on behalf of the corporation or bind it to any action but may make recommendations to the Board of Directors or the officers.

Section 3.12. Election Procedure. The nominating committee shall provide each Director with a list of officers thirty (30) days prior to the annual meeting. The slate of officers shall be presented for vote at the annual meeting. A vote of a majority of duly qualified Directors shall be required to elect officers.

ARTICLE IV COMMITTEES

Section 4.01. Nominating Committee. A nominating committee of at least three (3). Directors shall be appointed at the annual meeting each year. The nominating committee shall produce a list of Directors willing to serve as officers. The list of officers shall be presented to all duly qualified Directors at least thirty (30) days prior to the annual meeting. Officers shall be elected at the annual meeting as prescribed by these bylaws.

The nominating committee shall be responsible for preparing a slate of candidates willing to fill Director vacancies or designated Director additions. The list of candidates shall be presented to all duly qualified Directors at least thirty (30) days prior to the meeting. Nominations from the floor in both the instance of officers and Directors shall be allowed.

Section 4.02. Other Committees. The Board of Directors may act by and through such other committees to the extent as allowed by law as may be specified in resolutions adopted by a majority of the whole number of Directors. Each such committee shall have such duties and responsibilities as are granted to it by the Board of Directors. Each such committee shall at all times be subject to the direction of the Chairman of the Board of Directors,

ARTICLE V FISCAL AGENTS

This corporation may designate such fiscal agents, investment advisors and custodians as the Board of Directors may select by resolution. The Board of Directors may at any time, with or without cause, discontinue the use of the services of any such fiscal agent, investment advisor, or custodian.

ARTICLES VI FIDUCIARY DUTY

It shall be the policy of this corporation that the Board of Directors shall assume and discharge fiduciary responsibility with respect to all funds held or administered by this corporation.

**ARTICLE VII
POLICIES WITH RESPECT TO
DISTRIBUTION OF PRINCIPAL AND
INCOME AND RELATED MATTERS**

Section 7.01. Annual Distributions. It shall be the policy of this corporation to make annual distributions for one or more of the educational purposes for which it is organized, including administrative expenses and amounts paid to acquire an asset used (or held for use) directly in carrying out one or more of its purposes, in an amount determined by the Board of Directors to be appropriate. In any such distribution of funds no discrimination shall be made on account of the age, sex, color, religious affiliation or national origin of the individuals or programs to be benefitted thereby.

Section 7.02. No Self-Dealing. It shall be the policy of this corporation not to engage in any act which would constitute "self-dealing" as defined in Section 4941 (d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

Section 7.03. No Jeopardy Investments. It shall be the policy of this corporation to assure that no funds, whether title thereto is vested in this corporation or is vested in a trust for the benefit of this corporation, are invested or reinvested in such a manner as to jeopardize the carrying out of any educational purposes for which this corporation is organized.

Section 7.04. Expenditure Responsibility. It shall be the policy of this corporation that this corporation, through its Board of Directors, will exercise "expenditure responsibility", as defined in Section 4945 (h) (1) and (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or as hereafter amended, with respect to all grants and distributions.

Section 7.05. Reasonable Return. The Board of Directors shall take steps to assure that each Director, agent, or custodian with respect to the aggregate of the unrestricted trusts or funds that are, a component part of this corporation, administer such trust or fund in accordance with accepted standards of fiduciary conduct to produce a reasonable (as determined by the Board of Directors) return of net income, in furtherance of this corporation's educational purposes.

**ARTICLE VIII
BOOKS OF RECORD, AUDIT, FISCAL YEAR, BOND**

Section 8.01. Books and Records. The Board of Directors of this corporation shall cause to be kept: records of all proceedings of the Board of Directors, and Committees thereof; and all financial statements of this corporation; and Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of this Corporation and all amendments thereto and restatements thereof; and (4) such other records and books of account as shall be necessary and appropriate to the conduct of the corporate business.

Section 8.02. Audit and Publication. The Board of Directors shall cause the records and books of account of this corporation to be audited at least once in each fiscal year in such a manner as may be deemed necessary or appropriate, and also shall make such inquiry as the

Board of Directors deems necessary or advisable into the condition of all trusts and funds held by any Director, agent or custodian for the benefit of this corporation, and shall retain such person or firm for such purposes as it may deem appropriate. Not later than six months after the close of each fiscal year of this corporation, the Board of Directors of this corporation shall furnish to the Board of Education of Lyons School District 103 copies of the corporation's financial statements for the immediately preceding fiscal year.

Section 8.03. Fiscal Year. The fiscal year of the corporation shall end on June 30 of each year.

Section 8.04. Bond. The corporation shall obtain bond on such people and in such amounts as may from time to time be deemed necessary by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IX WAIVER OF NOTICE

Whenever any notice is required to be given by these Bylaws or any of the corporate laws of the State of Illinois, such notice may be waived in writing, signed by the person or persons entitled to said notice, whether before, at, or after the time stated therein, or before, at, or after the meeting.

ARTICLE X INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE

(a) The corporation shall indemnify any person who was or is a party, or is threatened to be made a party to any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative (other than an action by or in the right of the corporation) by reason of the fact that he or she is or was a Director, officer, employee or agent of the corporation, to the full extent permitted under the Illinois "General Not For Profit Corporation Act of 1986," as in effect from time to time.

(b) The corporation may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of any person who is or was a Director, officer, employee or agent of the corporation, or who is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a Director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise, against any liability asserted against such person and incurred by such person in any such capacity, or arising out of his or her status as such, whether or not the corporation would have the power to indemnify such person against such liability under the provisions of paragraph (a) of Article X of these Bylaws.

ARTICLE XI AMENDMENTS

The Board of Directors may amend this corporation's Articles of Incorporation, as heretofore or hereafter from time to time amended or restated, and these Bylaws as from time to time amended or restated, to include or omit any provision which could be lawfully included or omitted. Any number of amendments, or an entire revision or restatement of the Articles of

Incorporation or Bylaws, either may be submitted and voted upon at a single meeting of the Board of Directors and be adopted at such meeting a quorum being present, upon receiving the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the whole number of Directors; provided, however, that amendment of the Purpose clause of the Articles of Incorporation may be made only with the approval and resolution of three-fourths of all qualified Directors. Any proposed amendments shall be presented to the Directors thirty (30) days prior to the meeting when Board action is to be taken.

ARTICLE XII DISSOLUTION

(a) Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, distribute any remaining assets to one or more organizations that are organized and operated exclusively for charitable or educational purposes and that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

(b) Preference shall be given to distributing assets to an organization or organizations that support the educational programs, students, or staff of Lyons School District 103 or serve a similar educational purpose, as determined by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

(c) If no such qualifying organization exists, or if no suitable recipient is identified, any remaining assets shall be distributed to the Lyons School District 103 or, if permissible under applicable laws, to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public educational purpose.

WHEREAS, The School District on September 24, 2024, appointed Sara Andreas; and

WHEREAS, Sara Andreas is no longer able to serve as the Township Schools Trustee for School District 103 due to other obligations; and

WHEREAS, the School District declares a vacancy in that seat and now seeks to appoint William Channell to serve as the Township Schools Trustee Member for School District 103 for the remainder of the two-year term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of School District 103, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: That all recitals and legislative findings contained in the preambles to this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The School Board approves to appoint Assistant Business Manager, William Channell to serve as the trustee for the Township Trustee of Schools on behalf of School District 103 for the remainder of the two-year term. This person is expected to attend all meetings of the Township Trustee of Schools.

Section 3: If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

Section 4: All resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage provided by law.
