We look forward to 2024 and what that has in store for AES

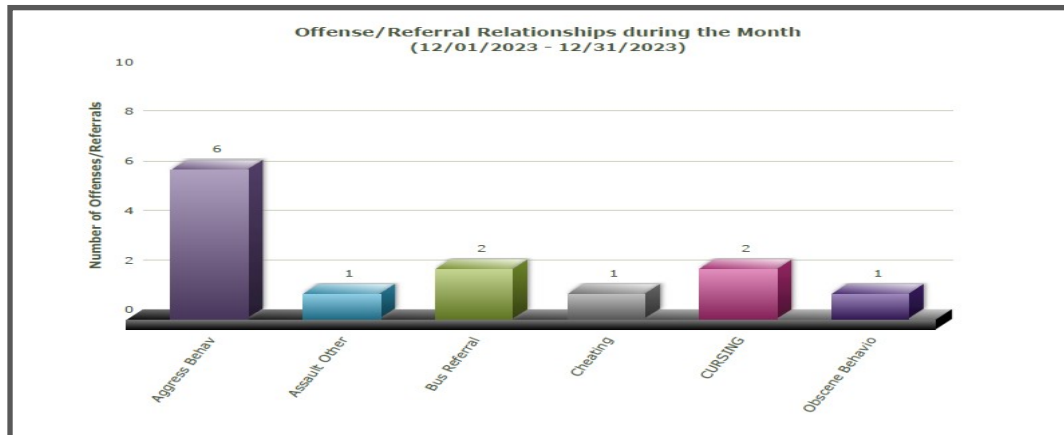

# AHS Board Report December 2023

## **Math Dept**

- Algebra 1 just finished wrapping up everything about linear functions and is about to start a new unit involving exponents and polynomials.
- Algebra 2- We are covering absolute value functions and transformations of those functions compared to their parent functions. We recently covered finding domain and range, how to solve absolute value equations, and graphing equations as well as inequalities. This topic is a combination of everything we have covered thus far.
- Algebraic Reasoning- We have discussed standard form, slope-intercept form, how to find the x- and y- intercepts, and writing linear equations given a point and slope. These are all topics covered in Algebra 1 that students have applied new concepts to, like working with fractions, graphing these equations, etc.
- We are wrapping up the semester with Similar and Congruent Triangles.
- Precalculus just finished solving Polynomial and Rational Inequalities. They are starting exponential and Logarithmic functions.
- Honors Algebra 2 students are graphing Quadratics by hand and finding the x-intercepts, y-intercept, vertex and axis of symmetry without a calculator.
- College Prep Math classes have started Reviewing for the Final Exam.
- College Algebra Prep is testing over Systems this week and reviewing for the TSIA.

## **Social Studies Dept**

- Government- Students have been completing a project over different government agencies that work within our executive branch.
- US History- U.S. History is learning about WWI and the impact it had on society.
- A.P. History is learning about the Market Revolution and the rise of political parties in the United States.
- World History- Exploring Ancient Rome
- World Geography- South America

## **CTE Dept**

- Medical Terminology- Started defining medical terms within the respiratory system and breaking them down into their root/prefix/suffix
- Prin. of Education- Creating a graduation plan and learning about different specific educational careers
- In business management we are working<sup>6</sup> on basic economic concepts.
- In personal finance we are learning about how to buy a house.

- Sports Medicine 1- Practicing spine boarding an injured athlete from a supine and prone position
- Sports Medicine 2- Creating a lower extremity model of the muscles and nerves using clay for the muscles and yarn for the nerves
- Sports Medicine 3- Continuing to help with treatments while also reviewing hands-on skills learned throughout sports med 1-3 preparing them for their final exam. These hands-on skills include taping, orthopedic special tests, anatomical movements, splinting, anatomical bony landmark identification, therapeutic modality set-up, and creating rehabilitation exercises for specific injuries.
- Anatomy - we are learning the muscles of the body and how the muscle contracts. We will be building a model of a skeletal muscle
- Forensics - we are studying fingerprints as evidence. We have made 10 print cards of everyone's fingerprints and classified them according to the pattern.

## 2022-2023 School Year AISD Emergent Bilingual (EB) Program Report

### **IDENTIFICATION**

If a newly enrolled student to Texas schools enrolls and has a home language survey with any other language other than English, the student is tested to determine the level of English proficiency using the LAS Links or PreLAS Links assessment.

Per Federal and State guidelines -

- PK-K student receives a 1, 2, or 3 oral language proficiency level, they are to be classified as an Emergent Bilingual
- PK-K student receives a 4 or 5 oral language level, they are considered Fluent and not to be identified as Emergent Bilingual
- 1st grade student receives a 1, 2, or 3 proficiency level in either Speaking and/or Listening, they are to be classified as an Emergent Bilingual; if they receive a 4 or 5 in both Speaking and Listening, they are considered English proficient.
- 2nd-12th grades student receives a 1, 2, or 3 in any domain (speaking, listening, reading, and/or writing) they are to be classified as an Emergent Bilingual; if they receive a 4 or 5 in all domains (Speaking, Listening, Reading, and Writing) they are to be considered fluent and not identified as Emergent Bilingual.

## **Bilingual - Exception Waiver**

Districts that are unable to provide appropriately certified teachers to implement a bilingual education program must request an exception for the bilingual education program and approval to offer a temporary alternative language program.

For the 2023-2024 school year, we applied for a Bilingual Exception waiver with TEA because there are more than 20 identified EB students who speak the same language in the 4th grade. This waiver is only for this grade level.

For the 2022-2023 school year, we applied for a Bilingual Exception for the same group of 3rd graders.

- 9th-12th: Pull-out ESL Program services - English teachers are ESL certified and provide language services through their English curriculum

## **22-23 SUMMER PROGRAM**

The summer school program was 15 days long or 120 hours of instruction that was provided by Mrs. McCreight. Students took many instructional trips including field trips to the Eddie V. Gray Wetlands Center, the Anahuac Wildlife Refuge and Double Bayou Park, the Wallisville Museum, a public library visit, the Houston Museum of Natural Science in Sugarland, the Anahuac Fire Station, the bank, the Bayou Zoo in Alvin, and the Houston Children’s Museum.
