Trustee Election

1. Background:

On May 3, 2025, Southwest ISD held a joint election with the City of Lytle to fill two at large places on the Board currently held by Ida Sudolcan, and Sylvester Vasquez. There was a total of 4 candidates running for these two positions.

Early voting was conducted at the District Administration Building and McAuliffe Middle School from April 22 through April 29, 2025. Election day voting was conducted from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 3, 2025.

2. Process:

The District contracted the Bexar County Elections office to perform the election duties on behalf of the district.

3. Fiscal Impact:

The District will expend about \$38,700 for this election.

4. Recommendation:

That the Board approve the canvass of the 2025 School Board Election results and declare Ms. Ida Sudolcan, and Mr. Sylvester Vasquez as the winners.
