
TOTAL ENROLLMENT: 419 students

The HS Band performed in front of the Kleberg County Courthouse on May 6th for the National Day of Prayer.

On Cinco de Mayo, our Mariachi performed for the HS. It was our first live performance this year and the first time they performed in their traje.

Our Mariachi Leon performed Mother's Day Serenades on May 7th and May 10th. On the 7th, the Mariachi performed for each campus, the Kleberg County Senior Center's luncheon, and various location where the student's mother's worked. What originally started out being about 5 performances became 12. While here at the ranch, we got permission to take pictures in front of the stables and ended up doing a quick performance for two individuals who were taking a ranch tour from California. On May 10th, the Mariachi performed for the Kingsville Housing Authority.

are new as the last three are seniors. Drum Majors Emily Perez and Sergio Soto just completed 3years of being Drum Majors.

We have 11 our colorguard set and our auditions for colorguard Captain will be on Thursday.

Our 3 UIL State Solo and Ensemble participants recorded again for competition and the judging will take place at the end of the month.

Mariachi Leon participated in UIL Region Mariachi competition and received a 1st Division Rating and advanced to the UIL State Mariachi Festival for the 3rd year in a row. That festival will take place either June 18th or 19th in Seguin. We'll know once UIL sets the schedule.

UIL is making changes to the Mariachi process. Currently, the Mariachi follows the UIL Solo and Ensemble format. Each group member is entered individually and they perform for 1 judge. Next year, the groups will follow the Concert band format and be entered as a single group and perform for 3 judges. The rule change that may affect us, is UIL categorizes Mariachi as Traditional or experimental and only traditional mariachis will eligible for the State Festival. We enter as an experimental Mariachi due to our inclusion of a flute player and violas.

Our All State Band student, Sergio Soto will participate in the ATSSB All-State Band clinic and Concert in Melissa, TX June 9th-12th. We will drive up on June 8th.

Band is also preparing to perform at Graduation on Friday.
