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NORTH SHORE SCHOOL DISTRICT 112 BOARD OF EDUCATION SELECTS ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT FOR FINANCE & OPERATIONS

Highland Park, Highwood and Fort Sheridan, IL – Tonight, the North Shore School District 112 (NSSD112) Board of Education unanimously approved the hiring of Mr. Jeremy Davis as Assistant Superintendent for Finance & Operations effective July 1, 2021. Mr. Davis currently serves as Assistant Superintendent of Finance and Operations at Community High School District 155 in Crystal Lake, IL.

“Mr. Davis impressed us from the outset of this search with his relationship building skills, positive vision, and his proven ability to establish a strong foundation of fiscal management,” said Dr. Michael Lubelfeld NSSD112 Superintendent of Schools. “The board and administration is proud to welcome Mr. Davis to District 112. We are confident that he has the skills needed to optimize our resources to achieve educational excellence for all students.”

The appointment of Mr. Davis comes after an extensive search process that consisted of multiple levels of in-depth interviews including consultative services from a human capital management firm. In addition, there were a series of interviews with a stakeholder selection committee. The selection committee consisted of district leadership, school principals, board members, and labor union leadership. In the Assistant Superintendent for Finance & Operations position, Mr. Davis will be charged with, among other things, addressing school/district financial needs, fiscal projections, as well as district operations such as facilities management, contracted services, construction, transportation, and foodservice.

“Dr. Lubelfeld has created a team of dynamic administrators here in District 112, and I am both honored and humbled to become a part of that team,” said Mr. Davis. “The reputation of NSSD112 is outstanding, and I can’t wait to get started on July 1 and help provide a world-class education to our students.”

Mr. Davis is a school fiscal management veteran having served schools and districts as a chief school business official for nearly 14 years. Mr. Davis has served District 155 for the past five years and is responsible for management of all financial and accounting functions for the district, development of short and long term financial plans and projections while overseeing various areas such as facilities, construction, transportation, food service, and risk management.

Mr. Davis is a highly successful school business manager who has a reputation for developing meaningful relationships with many school stakeholder groups including district leaders, union leadership, teachers, department leaders, district staff and others. He demonstrates on a regular basis that he is a proactive and resourceful problem solver by building consensus, displaying accuracy in financial reporting, and inspiring his direct reports and inter-departmental staff alike.

Mr. Davis’ two-year contract starts on July 1, 2021, at an annual salary of \$185,000.
