I. Establishment of a Quorum and Call to Order

D. Harris, Chair, called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m. and noted a quorum was present.

II. Pledge of Allegiance

L. Mara, Secretary made a motion to move to executive session to discuss communication and personnel matter. Dr. Jacqueline Jacoby, William Joslyn, and Chris Chinni were asked to join Superintendent James Thompson and the board for the executive session.

III. Presentations

IIIA. District Data Dashboard

B. Silver shared draft of District Data Dashboard with overview of criteria developed by the Data Dashboard Subcommittee for Bloomfield's District Data Team. The document provides the proposed student outcome indicators for BPS Data Dashboard for academics, Climate, and college and career readiness indicators.

L. Mara asked if the dashboard includes Arts, physical education.

J. Thompson - State used to require a physical education test.

As a board member we look at a child as a whole and including these other indicators are part of that view.

Climate Indicators includes suspension data

M. Walters - What are the responsibilities of the school system when students are suspended?

E. Stoltz - Obligation that any child suspended cumulatively for 10 or more days receives tutoring to make up any time missed beyond the 10 days; school provides work missed for both in-school and out-of-school suspensions.

College Indicators includes SAT results, graduation rate, percent of students enrolled in post-secondary settings, students heading to career pathway.

H. Frydman - Can we compare with other surrounding town or state - in any indicator.

J. Thompson - when we administer the SBAC then you will see how Bloomfield compares to other towns across the country and even internationally.

J. Jacoby - How many communities have data dashboard?

J. Thompson - very few districts have the elements included in this retreat agenda - Data Dashboard and Board Theory of

Action. Also, very few boards have created and approved a board self-evaluation.

L. Mara - has everyone been included in the indicator inclusion, example, special education, or Learning Academy of Bloomfield. When we send youngsters to community colleges we hear that they need remedial work. Can we know if this is the case and to what extent?

M. Walters - Due to legislation community colleges are not allowed to provide remediation any longer.

E. Pierce - The AT&T grant supports the funds for remediation to be completed while students are still in high school.

S. True - What do we have in place for exceptional students?

E. Stoltz - Arace offers a Talented and Gifted program, BHS offers AP courses and rigorous courses, such as Calculus 2 and 5 classes of Physics; GEMS' students take college courses on the Goodwin College campus

D. Harris - no indicator for AP?

B. Silver - can be added

IIIB. Development of Board Theory of Action (ToA)

E. Stoltz - introduction of Dr. Patrick Proctor.

P. Proctor - Data Dashboard - priorities of how to look at how the district is doing in preparing students.

- PowerPoint presentation included
- Agenda of the work covered
- Biggest idea is that the Board Theory of Action is aligned and supports the district theory of action. It must be actionable.
- Goal is to have a crafted ToA with the help of volunteers to help complete the work.

- First Big Step for Bloomfield: convening community stakeholders: Why do this? Discussion between members of the board and district leadership.
 - Purposes with respect to adults?
 - Awareness
 - Inclusive
 - Buy in
 - Respect for their ideas and the school system
 - Change perception
 - Expand mission
 - Provide direction
 - Purposes with respect to children?
 - Same as above and more
 - Outcome
 - Expand their vision
 - Attitudes disposition and beliefs
 - Enthusiasm/motivation
 - Rigor
 - opportunity
- "If, then, resulting in": Example If Stakeholder meet and identify belief, then adults at all levels change beliefs, vision, etc. then results in student change, improvement, etc.
- "Connecting District's strategic work with its intended impact on adult practices and student learning."

- If the strategic work does not make it to the classroom, then it doesn't exist. "through - line" to instructional core.
- Promotes successive level of detail and precision in adult work.
- Presented Bloomfield Theory of Action. Board asked to think about the three elements of a Theory of Action. Then:
 - Data to drive decision making
 - Collaboratively
 - Doing this successfully
 - Comprehensive - full range
 - At every level - board, data teams at every level, leadership
 - Professional Capital - book that
- Resulting:
 - Learning for all students will substantially improve and sustained over time.
 - Not at a level of detail but provided the framework to take it to the next level of action.
- Level of precision: sample of District Accountability Plan (DAP)
 - Statement of 4 priorities for the district:
 - Holistic Accountability
 - Strengthen curriculum, instruction and assessment
 - Positive School Climate
 - Parent and Community Engagement

- o Defining Characteristics - drive the District Accountability Plan
- o DAP - provides detailed, interconnected action strategies (Theory of Action) for successful implementation and results.
- o Summary Slide - Explicit ToA-Purpose/Process/Impact
 - Makes beliefs and assumptions that guide our strategic work clear, actionable, and provable
 - Provides focus and coherence regarding the overall improvement agenda and the strategic work of the organization
 - Identifies and prioritizes the critical necessary to improve adult practices and student outcomes
- o 9 domains of the Board's work which, if done, will have an impact on the adults of the district.
- o ToA - functions in direct support of and accountability with the District's Executive Leadership Team - reciprocal accountability.
 - Give support and hold accountable
- o Review of Board Self Evaluation 9 Domains
 - "If" statements are in the Domains
- o Prioritize Domains
 - Identify High impact domains- impact adult work and influence student outcomes
 - High Leverage
- o Each member will pick three priorities within the 9 domains

- o Share results of prioritization with group
- o Facilitator posted the group work to find commonality. Board member reported on results of the group thinking.

V. Presentations

A. Student Representative Reports

J. Jackson (Bloomfield High School) and J. Lawrence (Global Experience Magnet School) reviewed the numerous school activities, including academics, athletics, travel opportunities and community involvement.

VI. Public/PTO Comment

P. Davis of Lisa Lane, chair of the Carmen Arace PTO, was attending this meeting to express the budget request of the Carmen Arace parents. Their request is to consider no teacher layoffs. They expressed this stating it was in the best interest of the student body. An invitation was extended to the board member to attend the January 23 PTO meeting at 6:30PM.

VII. Superintendent's Report

A. Connecticut Academic Performance Test (CAPT) – 2013 Recognition Letters

Two students, Johneilia Bariffe and Brittany Nelson received letters from the CT State Department of Education in recognition of their Advanced Level CAPT results and their school and community service.

B. Financial Report – December 31, 2013

J. Jacoby presented the one and six page monthly financial reports. To date the figures reflect the budget is healthy for the 2013 - 2014 year. No transfers were requested.

S. McCann reviewed the benchmark assessment definitions and its alignment to the District Accountability Plan. The Principals or their representative, of Metacomet, CAIS, CAMS BHS and GEMS presented the areas of strength followed up with areas of focus. After each presentation, the board members asked numerous questions resulting in discussion around the connection between literacy and numeracy, the impact of the data teams, student involvement in their personal plans and journals, parental involvement, the continuity between all the schools from Pre-K through high school, and setting aggressive goals.

The students receiving the SDE letters this evening are witness to the turnaround of the district. The fall sports awards banquet recognized the many scholar athletes in Bloomfield. Safety and Technical grants have been applied for by the district grant writer. The continuity of Pre-K through 12 was acknowledged. Individualized student plans are involving the student in their development. Board members reiterated their approval of ambitious targets. Compliments were extended for the tenacious focus on student achievement and applaud the graduation numbers and college enrollment. Next the framework of the Theory of Action Worksheet was populated with information derived from intense discussion by attendees.

The next steps will include finalizing and approving the Theory of Action. Determine how current board work should be adjusted to align with the approved Theory of Action. Determine a monitoring system to improve and sustain the work of the board. Finally, determine how the BoE self evaluation process will be conducted in context of the BoE Theory of Action.
