**3. NEW BUSINESS**

**3. A. Policy for Initial Reading**

**1. Non-Resident Students - 5118**

Mr. Guzman, Chief Operations Officer presented a new policy to the committee for an initial reading.

This policy states that free school privileges are provided to all resident students.

The administrative regulations for this policy provides flexibility for the Superintendent to allow a non-resident students to start or continue school for the purpose of a non-interrupted education. For instance, a family moving into the district may start on time if sufficient documentation proves they will be residents of Bloomfield. In addition these regulations would allow a 12<sup>th</sup> grade student who is moving out district in late spring, to remain in district for the remainder of their senior year with approval.



A motion was made by D. Banks and seconded by Q. Johnson to recommend to the full Board of Education, the initial reading of policy 5118 – Non-Resident Students.

The motion passed unanimously.
