3. A. Policy for Initial Reading

3.A.1. Reporting of Child Abuse and Neglect – 5141.4

Mr. William Guzman, Chief Operations Officer presented an initial reading of policy 5141.4 – Reporting of Child Abuse and Neglect.

This policy is being revised in compliance with State Statue P.A. 18-17. The policy now includes licensed behavioral analyst in the list of mandated reporters. Additional updates to the language include the timeline to file an oral and written report, notice that state law prohibits retaliation against a mandated reporter for fulfilling his or her obligations to report, and the annual certification of staff to receive professional development on mandated reporting.

A motion was made by R. Ike and seconded by D. Bolton to recommend to the full Board of Education, an initial reading of the policy 5141.4 – Reporting of Child Abuse and Neglect.

The motion passed unanimously.
