1. CALL TO ORDER

M. Walters called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. The roll was called and a quorum was present.

2. CONSENT AGENDA

2. A. Approval of Minutes – Curriculum Committee – April 23, 2019

A motion was made by R. Ike and seconded by M. Walters for the Curriculum Committee to approve the minutes from April 23, 2019 regular committee meeting, as presented.

The motion was passed unanimously.

3. NEW BUSINESS

3. A. 2017-2018 Performance and Profile Report

Dr. Bethany Silver presented the 2017-2018 Performance and Profile report provided by the Connecticut State Department of Education. This report replaces the old state report called the Strategic School Profile.

The first section is an overview of the district. The district section was reviewed and the school sections were provided for information only.

Dr. Silver pointed out the student enrollment and chronic absenteeism data on page one. The Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Staff table is on page two along with educator demographics. Also noted on page two is the percentage of Black or African American educators, which is 21.3% in Bloomfield, which is about 6 times the state average. Dr. Silver added that the state references Bloomfield as a district leading minority teacher recruitment and retention.

Dr. Silver stated the expenditure information on page three is from 2016-2017.

The District Performance Index (DPI) on page four shows the performance on the state summative assessments, the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) and the Physical Fitness Test information.



Dr. Silver explained the data from the charts showing the graduation rates, college and career readiness performance data and the college entrance rates on page five. Page seven of the Performance and Profile report provides a narrative for the Bloomfield School District which emphasizes our priorities and our efforts to reduce, ethnic and economic isolation.

Ms. Davis observed that the data is not disaggregated by transgender students.
