1. CALL TO ORDER

H. Frydman called the meeting to order at 6:59 p.m. The roll was called and a quorum was present.

2. CONSENT AGENDA

2. A. Approval of Minutes – Policy Committee Meeting – January 28, 2020

A motion was made by D. Harris and seconded by R. Ike for the Policy Committee to approve the minutes from the January 28, 2020 meeting, as presented.

The motion passed unanimously.

3. OLD BUSINESS

3. A. Policy for Second Reading

3.A.1. Adult Education - 622

Mr. William Guzman, Chief Operations Officer presented Policy 6200 – Adult Education to the Committee for a second reading.

This policy went to the Board of Education for an initial reading on February 18, 2020. This is an entirely new policy that speaks to adult continuing education and aligned with the Adult Education audit conducted with by the State Department of Education.



This policy is not a mandated by state statute but recommended as good practice by the Connecticut Association of Board of Education (CABE).

D. Harris inquired if we have any limitations regarding the time between the first and second reading of this policy. Mr. Guzman did not believe there are limitations but would follow-up.

A motion was made by D. Harris and seconded by R. Ike to recommend to the Board of Education a second reading of the policy 6200 – Adult Education.

The motion passed unanimously.

4. NEW BUSINESS

4. A. Policy for an Initial Reading

4.A.1. District Goals - 0200

Mr. William Guzman, Chief Operations Officer, presented policy 0200 – District Goals. This is an existing policy with language added to line #9.

The additional language a result of Public Act 19-58 which was an act promoting careers and manufacturing to public school students and establishment of a task force to study the demand of career and technical education. This is a mandated policy to ensure school districts are offering students options to look at careers for those who do not want to pursue post-secondary education.

A motion was made by D. Harris and seconded by R. Ike to recommend to the Board of Education an initial reading of the policy 0200 – District Goals.

The motion passed unanimously.
