1. CALL TO ORDER

L. Easmon called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. The roll was called and a quorum was present.

2. CONSENT AGENDA

2. A. Approval of Minutes – Finance Committee – September 30, 2021

A motion was made by D. Harris and seconded by L. Easmon for the Finance Committee to approve the meeting minutes from September 30, 2021, as presented.

The motion was passed unanimously.

3. NEW BUSINESS

3. A. Status Report – ESSER Grants

Mr. William Guzman, Chief Operations Officer gave an overview of the recent federal grants.

Elisa Pierce, District Grants Specialist, shared a brief synopsis of the ESSER I, ESSER II and ESSER III (ARP) grants. The excel spreadsheet showed the allocation amount, grant balances and grant closing dates.

L. Easmon asked if there can be a breakdown of the ESSER I funds, which has already been closed out. The majority of the funds was used for reopening of schools in the fall of 2020. These funds were used to pay for certified staff, nurses, recommissioning of HVAC, cleaning services, storage facilities, personal protective equipment, signage, and



art supplies. In addition, some funds (\$24,518) were allocated to non-public schools in town, as stipulated by the grant.
