1. CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Wilkerson called the meeting to order at 6:57 p.m. The roll was called and a quorum was present.

2. CONSENT AGENDA

2. A. Approval of Minutes – Policy Committee Meeting – March 29, 2022

A motion was made by H. Frydman and seconded by R. Ike for the Policy Committee to approve the minutes from March 29, 2022 special meeting, as presented.

The motion passed unanimously.

3. OLD BUSINESS

3. A. Policy for Second Reading

3.A.1. Individualized Education Program/Special Education Program – 6159

Mr. William Guzman, Chief Operations Officer, presented policy 6159 - Individualized Education Program/Special Education Program. This policy was before the Policy Committee on March 29, 2022 and to the full Board for an initial reading on April 6, 2022.

This policy change is the result of a state court decision. All students with disabilities who have not reached the age of 22 years and have not received a high school diploma, remain eligible for special educational services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).



This policy is revised to be in compliance with the court ruling.

A motion was made by J. Wilkerson and seconded by R. Ike to recommend to the Board of Education for adoption, policy 6159 – Individualized Education Program/Special Education Program.

The motion passed unanimously.

3.A.2. Drug and Alcohol Testing for School Bus Drivers – 4212.42

Policy 4212.42 - Drug and Alcohol Testing for School Bus Drivers was presented for a second reading. This policy was before the Policy Committee on March 29, 2022 and to the full Board for an initial reading on April 6, 2022.

This policy results from an action taken by the United States Department of Transportation amending the rules for commercial drivers license drug and alcohol clearing house. This policy stated the transportation company ensures all contractors will establish a drug and alcohol testing program.

A motion was made by H. Frydman and seconded by R. Ike to recommend to the Board of Education for adoption, policy 4212 – Drug and Alcohol Testing for School Bus Drivers.

The motion passed unanimously.

4. NEW BUSINESS

4. A. Policies for an Initial Reading

4.A.1. Title IX Personnel/Students – 4000.1/5145.44

This policy is a result of the Office of Federal Rights at the federal level proposing new rule to amend the Title IX regulation.

The new regulations list three conditions as listed on page 3 of amended policy pertaining to sexual harassment. New provision also addresses prevention and response of the district.

A motion was made by H. Frydman and seconded by R. Ike to recommend to the Board of Education an initial reading of policy 5145.44 – Title IX - Students.

The motion passed unanimously
