1. CALL TO ORDER

3. NEW BUSINESS

A. Status Report – Special Education Transportation 2023-2024

Mr. William Guzman, Chief Operations Officer gave an update on the history of Access and Haven transportation companies.

Mr. Jason Titelbaum, District Data Systems Coordinator gave an updated to the Board of Education Finance Committee on where the district stands in the request for proposal (RFP) process for special education bus transportation for 2023-2024. Bids are due by May 1, 2023. The current transportation contract expires on June 30, 2023 and Access Transportation was not prepared to negotiate their contract.

It was further noted that the Finance Committee will receive an update at the May Finance Committee meeting and a recommendation will be made to the full Board of Education.

L. Easmon requested current Special Education transportation costs with details prior to next meeting.

H. Frydman would like to know the age of the buses and how many companies there are in Connecticut that currently provide special education transportation.
