III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A. Approval of minutes from the December 12, 2025 Safety & Security Committee Meeting.

IV. DISCUSSION OF SAFETY & SECURITY TOPICS

A. Announcements

1. Physical Security & Threat Prevention

a. Physical Security Upgrades / Enhancements

Updates focused on continued efforts to strengthen the district's overall "security ecosystem," emphasizing integration across systems rather than isolated upgrades. No new capital projects.

b. Radio Infrastructure Project Update

Contract negotiations with NORCOM were revised to remove risk-laden assumptions and future-proof the investment. Timeline significantly shortened from an estimated 18 months to 8-16 weeks once contracts are finalized. Each school will receive its own repeater and antenna, creating independent yet interconnected communication zones. The system will include noise-canceling digital radios, crisis-team channels, and limited video-enabled radios for SROs and security leadership. The system will integrate with Weston Police dispatch for real-time monitoring, improving emergency response coordination. Full district implementation is anticipated by late summer / early fall 2026.

c. Burglar Alarm Monitoring Equipment Update

The district transitioned burglar alarm monitoring back to Omnidata, resulting in modest cost savings and improved system reliability. Completion is expected to continue through summer when buildings are unoccupied

d. Updated MOU with Weston Police Department

An updated Memorandum of Understanding was finalized to support the Sandy Hook Anonymous Reporting System.

e. Safety & Security Policy

Older policies are being modernized to reflect current terminology and practices. Recent updates include fire emergencies, disaster preparedness, loitering, weapons, and sexual offender policies. Work is underway to update the School Resource Officer (SRO) policy so it aligns with the newly revised MOU. These updates are primarily technical and clarifying in nature, not substantive policy shifts.

2. Cybersecurity / IT

a. Cybersecurity Updates

Proactive firewall protections block traffic from high-risk regions. Ongoing staff phishing-awareness training has proven effective. Student email restrictions (K-8) limit exposure to external threats. All systems and vendors comply with Connecticut Student Privacy Act (PA 16-189) requirements. The district actively monitors emerging threats through state and regional intelligence sharing

b. SmartPass System

System provides real-time student accountability without real-time location tracking. Classroom Chromebooks are being deployed to streamline student use. Early feedback from staff has been positive, with full rollout expected shortly. Committee members discussed data retention, privacy, and the importance of evaluating effectiveness after sufficient use.
