NEW COURSE SUPPLEMENT

FOR 2021-22

Course Title: Advanced Placement (AP) Spanish Language and Culture

Department: RAHS World Language

Type: New Course

Background:

AP Spanish Language and Culture was added to the course registration handbook last year to replace the College in the Schools course Spanish 1003 and 1004 that were discontinued abruptly last year. This course offers students a rigorous college credit bearing course that is taught by Roseville Area High School teachers. The course provides the opportunity for students to discover how culture and language relate to families, personal identity, art, science, technology, economics, politics, and the environment. Students will have the opportunity to practice and communicate in Spanish through authentic situations including stories, letters, emails, and other real-world texts and practical applications. This is a course designed for students completing at least 4 years of Spanish or students who are in the DLI program. Students will have the opportunity to take the AP test at the completion of the course, with the possibility of earning college credit.
