MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING, SCHOOL BOARD, INDEPENDENT
SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 623, 1251 West County Road B2, Roseville, MN 55113

February 26, 2025

Chair Todd Anderson called the school board meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Board members present: Todd Anderson, Mike Boguszewski, Rose Chu, Mannix Clark, Kitty Gogins, Frank Shaw. Board members absent: none. Also present: Jenny Loeck, superintendent of schools, and approximately nineteen other visitors or staff who attended all or part of the meeting.

Summary of Community Input Received for Action Items. The board received no community input regarding the evening's action items.

- (48) Consent Agenda. Gogins moved, Clark seconded acceptance of the consent agenda, including the minutes of the school board meeting on February 10, 2025; payment of bills; resignations, appointments, reductions, adjustments; and gifts. Ayes: Anderson, Boguszewski, Chu, Clark, Gogins, Shaw. Nays: none. Motion carried unanimously.
- (49) Retirements. Chu moved, Gogins seconded the retirement of Laura Berkas with appreciation. Ayes: Anderson, Boguszewski, Chu, Clark, Gogins, Shaw. Nays: none. Motion carried unanimously.

Program Participation Report. Jake Von De Linde, executive director of teaching and learning; Niceta Thomas, executive director of student services; and Trina Hira, advanced academics and talent development coordinator, reported on student participation in programming including special education, advanced academics and talent development (formerly gifted and talented), and activities and athletics.

American Indian Program Report. Delon Smith, associate superintendent of equity and innovation; Gabriella Carroll, American Indian education program coordinator; and Savannah Rojas, American Indian cultural liaison, presented information about the district's American Indian education program. This program serves American Indian students throughout the district and promotes cultural awareness, academic advocacy, and community connection for students and families.

- (50) American Indian Education Transmittal of Resolution and Parent Committee Roster. School districts that enroll ten or more American Indian students are required by Minnesota law to establish an American Indian Parent Advisory Committee and complete a resolution of concurrence or non-concurrence each school year. Roseville Area Schools' AIPAC passed a resolution of non-concurrence on January 29, 2025. A resolution of non-concurrence means that the AIPAC finds that the district has not been meeting the needs of American Indian students. Gogins moved, Chu seconded acceptance of the American Indian Education transmittal of resolution and parent committee roster. Ayes: Anderson, Boguszewski, Chu, Clark, Gogins, Shaw. Nays: none. Motion carried unanimously.

- (51) 2025-2026 Achievement and Integration Budget. Delon Smith presented a summary of the Achievement and Integration (A&I) program budget for the 2025-2026 school year. The A&I for Minnesota program supports the pursuit of racial and economic integration, increased student achievement, the creation of equitable educational opportunities, and the reduction of academic disparities based on students' diverse racial, ethnic, and economic backgrounds in Minnesota public schools. The estimated budget for next year is \$1,821,550. Boguszewski moved, Clark seconded approval of the 2025-2026 Achievement and Integration budget as presented. Ayes: Anderson, Boguszewski, Chu, Clark, Gogins, Shaw. Nays: none. Motion carried unanimously.
- (52) Policy 400: Acceptable Use (revised) Second Reading. Gogins moved, Clark seconded approval of Policy 400: Acceptable Use. Ayes: Anderson, Boguszewski, Chu, Clark, Gogins, Shaw. Nays: none. Motion carried unanimously.
- (53) Approval of Final 2025-2026 and Draft 2026-2027 School Year Calendars. Chu moved, Shaw seconded approval of the final 2025-2026 and draft 2026-2027 school year calendars. Ayes: Anderson, Boguszewski, Chu, Clark, Gogins, Shaw. Nays: none. Motion carried unanimously.

Study Session Report. Director Gogins reported on the February 10 study session. The board reviewed the district's legislative priorities for the 2025 legislative session. Board members also participated in professional development led by the Office of Educational Equity.

Board Reports. Rose Chu attended an Early Childhood Family Education Council meeting and a legislative meet-and-greet hosted by the Ramsey County League of Local Governments. She attended a Community Advisory Committee meeting with Todd Anderson, and she and Kitty Gogins accepted an invitation to speak to students enrolled in a policy course at Macalester College. Mike Boguszewski attended an American Indian Parent Advisory Committee meeting. He also highlighted spirit week at Fairview Alternative High School and invited the community to attend Harambee Elementary School's upcoming pancake breakfast. Mannix Clark attended a Special Education Advisory Council meeting and, along with Rose Chu and Kitty Gogins, attended a Finance Advisory Committee meeting. Treasurer Clark also shared information about upcoming opportunities for tours of Northeast Metro 916 schools and programs. Kitty Gogins attended an LGBTQ+ Equity Council meeting, a quarterly meeting with local elected officials, and a meeting with local faith communities. Frank Shaw toured Roseville Area High School. Todd Anderson attended a District Curriculum Advisory Committee meeting.

Superintendent's Report. Superintendent Loeck thanked the community for its support of the district's immigrant students and families.

The Chair declared the meeting adjourned at 8:36 p.m.

Policy 500 – Acceleration and Retention

1.0 Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance to staff, parents/guardians, and students when considering student acceleration or retention.

2.0 Decisions regarding subject accelerations, grade accelerations and retentions will be based on evaluations conducted by a team consisting of the following:

2.1 Subject acceleration: classroom teacher, advanced academics and talent development coordinator, principal(s), parent(s)/guardian(s), and other staff as appropriate.

2.2 Grade acceleration: classroom teacher, advanced academics and talent development coordinator, school psychologist, principal(s), parent(s)/guardian(s), and other staff as appropriate.

2.3 Retention: classroom teacher, school psychologist, principal, parent(s)/guardian(s), and other staff as appropriate.

3.0 Informed by the evaluation and subsequent conversations, the principal(s) will determine student placement based on the best interests of the student. All decisions are subject to review for consistency by the superintendent or designee, whose decision will be final.
