- 551.084 Excluding witnesses from a hearing.

Should any final action, final decision, or final vote be required in the opinion of the School Board with regard to any matter considered in such closed or executive meeting or session, then the final action, final decision, or final vote shall be either:

- (a) in the open meeting covered by the Notice upon reconvening of the public meeting; or
- (b) at the subsequent public meeting of the School Board upon notice thereof as the School Board upon notice thereof as the School Board shall determine.

Burton ISD ESSA Public Comment

Burton ISD will receive ESSA funds for the 26-27 school year:

- Title I - \$133,255
- Title I Part C - \$1,396
 - We have a shared service arrangement with ESC6 so the funds go to them.
- Title II - \$18,638
- Title III - \$2,244
 - We have a shared service arrangement with ESC6 so the funds go to them.
- Title IV - \$10,044

The funds are split between the 2 campuses based on the percentage of our economically disadvantaged students and enrollment. Each campus is a school-wide Title I campus since we each have had at least 40% of our students who are economically disadvantaged in the past year. We will use the funds for a Math & Reading Interventionist, substitutes to allow teachers to attend professional development, professional development fees, supplemental supplies, and the fee service with ESC 6.
