**SCHOOL BOARD
INTERNAL ORGANIZATION**

The Latta Board of Education shall be organized at the beginning of the first meeting following the annual school election and certification of election of new members. The term of office of newly elected board members shall begin at the first regular, special, or emergency board meeting after the member has been certified as elected.

It is the custom of the board that the outgoing member of the board will automatically serve as president. The vice-president will be the next by term seniority. This custom may continue by majority vote at the annual organizational meeting. The board reserves the right to have open elections for any and all offices.

The president and vice-president shall each serve for a term of one year and until a successor is named and qualified. The board shall elect a clerk and, in its discretion, a deputy clerk, either of whom may be one of the members of the board, and each of whom shall hold office during the pleasure of the board and each of whom shall receive such compensation for services as the board may allow.

STUDENT TRANSFERS

The school district will not accept or deny a transfer based on ethnicity, national origin, gender, income level, disabling condition, proficiency in the English language, measure of achievement, aptitude or athletic ability. Receipt of applications will be documented by the district so that the district may review those applications in the order submitted for purposes of capacity limitations.

Transfers that have previously been approved by the school district will remain in effect for future school years unless the district provides notification to the parent or legal guardian that the transfer is not going to be continued for an upcoming school year due to disciplinary action or attendance issues. The district will not require parents resubmit a new application each school year and will advance the previous application of an enrolled student amending only the grade placement of the student.

A transfer may be requested at any time in the school year. State law does limit the ability of a student to transfer to no more than two (2) times per school year to one or more school districts in which the student does not reside. Exceptions to this limit will exist for students in foster care. Students are legally entitled to reenroll at any time in his or her school district of residence. Any brother or sister of a student who transferred in the previous school will be provided preferential treatment and approved regardless of capacity with only discipline and attendance records reviewed in the determination of the sibling transfer request. A separate application must be filed for each student so that the district can timely consider requests in the order applications are received.

A student who has attended school as a resident student for at least three years prior to moving out of the school district may be allowed to transfer into the district regardless of capacity. Such student's application will be reviewed utilizing only disciplinary records and attendance in the determination of the transfer request.

It is the policy of the board of education that any legally transferring student shall be accepted by the district under the following circumstances:

1. The district has the capacity to accept the student at the grade level at the school site;
2. The transferring student has not been disciplined for:
 - a. violation of a school regulation,
 - b. possession of an intoxicating beverage, low-point beer, as defined by Section 163.2 of Title 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or missing or stolen property if the property is reasonably suspected to have been taken from a student, a school employee, or the school during school activities, or
 - c. possession of a dangerous weapon or a controlled dangerous substance while on or within two thousand (2,000) feet of public school property, or at a school event, as defined in the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act.
3. The transferring student does not have a history of absences. "History of absences" means ten or more absences in one semester that are not excused for the reasons provided in 70 O.S. § 10-105 or due to illness.

By the first day of January, April, July and October, the board of education shall establish the number of transfer students the district has the capacity to accept in each grade level for each school site within the district. The number of transfer students for each grade level at each site that the district has the capacity to accept will be posted in a prominent place on the school district's website. The district shall report to the State Department of Education the number of transfer students for each grade level for each school site which the district has the capacity to accept.

The district has a capacity of 65 in Grade 8 at Latta Middle School.
The district has a capacity of 65 in Grade 9 at Latta High School.
The district has a capacity of 65 in Grade 10 at Latta High School.
The district has a capacity of 65 in Grade 11 at Latta High School.
The district has a capacity of 65 in Grade 12 at Latta High School.

A student shall be allowed to transfer to a district in which the parent or legal guardian of the student is employed as a teacher as per 70 O.S. § 8-113.

The district will approve or deny the application and notify the parent of the student of the determination in writing within thirty (30) days of receiving an application. The school district shall enroll transfer students in the order in which they submit their applications. If the number of student transfer applications exceeds the capacity of the district, the district shall select transfer students in the order in which the district received the application. Students who are the dependent children of a member of the active uniformed military services of the United States on full-time active-duty status and students who are the dependent children of the military reserve on active duty orders shall be eligible for admission to the school district regardless of capacity of the district. Students shall be eligible for military transfer if:

1. At least one parent of the student has a Department of Defense issued identification card; and
2. At least one parent can provide evidence that he or she will be on active-duty status or active-duty orders, meaning the parent will be temporarily transferred in compliance with official orders to another location in support of combat, contingency operation or a national disaster requiring the use of orders for more than thirty (30) consecutive days.

If the transfer application is accepted, the district shall notify the parents of the acceptance. The parent shall provide the district with written notification that the student will be enrolling within ten (10) days of notification of acceptance. Failure to notify the school district within ten (10) days of acceptance shall result in the cancellation of the transfer. The district will provide a written notice of the cancellation to the parent of the student immediately upon cancellation. If accepted, a student transfer is granted for the existing school year and may continue to attend in future years. At the end of the school year, the district may deny continued transfer of the student due to disciplinary reasons or a history of absences. Written notice of the intention to deny continued transfer of the student shall be given to a parent of a student no later than July 15. The parent may appeal the denial of a continued transfer.

TRANSFER POLICY(Cont.)

If a transfer request is denied by the school district, the district shall provide notification of the denial in writing to the parent by either hand-delivery, by U.S. Mail or electronic mail. The notification shall include:

1. An explanation including but not limited to any citation to the statute, regulation, or school district policy under which the denial was made;
2. A copy of the policy adopted by the district for determining the number of transfer students the school district has the capacity to accept;
3. A copy of 210:10-1-18.1 from the Administrative Code; and
4. The date upon which the appeal will be due.

If a transfer request is denied by the administration, the parent or legal guardian of the student may appeal the denial within ten (10) days of notification of denial to the board of education. If notification was hand-delivered, the appeal period shall begin the day after the notification is delivered. If notification is sent by U.S. Mail, the appeal period shall begin three (3) days after the notification is mailed. If notification is sent via electronic mail, the appeal period shall begin the day after the notification is sent. The board of education shall consider the appeal at its next regularly scheduled board meeting if notice is provided prior to the statutory deadline for posting the agenda for the meeting. The board of education shall accept an otherwise untimely appeal if a parent of a student can establish that they did not receive actual notice of the notification denying the transfer request, and the appeal was submitted within ten (10) days after the parent of the student actually received notice.

The appeal to the board of education shall be submitted to the office of the superintendent. The appeal shall include the following:

1. The name, address and telephone number of the parent of the student and the student for whom the appeal is being taken;
2. The date the district gave notice denying the transfer request;
3. The basis for appealing the decision of the school district; and
4. The name, address and telephone number of the legal representative, if applicable.

Appeal process: During the appeal, the board will review the action of the administration and the appeal paperwork submitted by the parent of the student to make sure that the district policy was followed with regard to the denial of the transfer. The board of education will meet in an executive session to review the educational records of the student. If the policy was not followed, the board of education shall return to open session to vote to overturn the denial and the transfer will be granted. This will be a paper appeal and will include the written documentation utilized by the school district as well as a written response from the parent or legal guardian which explains why the policy was not followed.

If the board of education votes to deny an appeal of a request to transfer, the board of education shall instruct the superintendent to provide notification of denial in writing to the parent of the student by either hand-delivery, by U.S.

Mail, or by electronic mail. The notification shall include:

1. An explanation, including the legal citation to the statute, regulation, or school district policy under which the denial was made;
2. A copy of the policy adopted by the board of education for determining the number of transfer students the district has capacity to accept;

TRANSFER POLICY(Cont.)

3. A copy of the State Board of Education's prescribed form for an appeal; and
4. A copy of 210:10-1-18.1 which identifies the Accreditation standard for appealing the denial of a student transfer.

If the board of education votes to uphold the denial of the transfer, the parent or legal guardian may appeal the denial within ten (10) days of the notification of the appeal denial to the State Board of Education. The parent or legal guardian shall submit to the State Board of Education and to the superintendent of the district, a notice of appeal on the form prescribed by the State Board of Education. The superintendent shall immediately provide a copy of the appeal to each member of the board of education. Upon receipt of notice of an appeal, but not later than five (5) days prior to the date at which the State Board of Education is scheduled to consider the appeal the board of education may submit a written response to the appeal. Responses should not exceed five (5) pages. If not submitted by the parent, the board of education shall provide a copy of the policy adopted to determine the number of transfer students the district has the capacity to accept in each grade level for each school site within the district. The parent and the school district will have an opportunity to appear in person or by authorized representative or by attorney to address the State Board at the meeting.

A student who enrolls in a school district in which the student is not a resident shall not be eligible to participate in school-related extramural athletic competition governed by the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association for a period of one (1) year from the first day of attendance at the receiving school unless the transfer is from a school district which does not offer the grade the student is entitled to pursue as per 70 O.S. § 8-103.2.

A POLICY ON THIS TOPIC IS REQUIRED BY LAW

**STUDENT ATTENDANCE
(REGULATION)**

In accordance with the policy of the board of education, all students PK-12 are required to be in attendance a minimum of 90% of the time. Failure to meet minimum attendance requirements may result in a student not receiving credit for a class or grade level. **When a student accrues 5 absences in a semester, the student may be referred to state or tribal court.**

ABSENCES

Excused absence will be granted for the following reasons:

1. Personal or family illnesses
2. Medical appointments
3. Legal matters, including service on a grand, multicounty grand, or petit jury *
4. Extenuating circumstances deemed necessary by the principal
5. Observance of holidays required by student's religious affiliation.

It is the responsibility of the parent to notify the school by 10:00 a.m. if a child is to be absent for one of the above reasons. The school will contact those students' parents who do not call. If no contact is made, the parent must send a note or call the day the child returns before the student can be excused. The student may promptly make up all work missed without penalty. It is the responsibility of the student, on the day of return, to make arrangements to see that the work is made up.

School Activity

1. The student will be allowed to be absent from the classroom for a maximum of ten days per semester to participate in activities sponsored by the school.
2. The student will be allowed to make up any work missed while participating.

At Latta Public Schools, we feel that extracurricular activities are an important part of the total school experience. We do realize that classroom participation and schoolwork are our main priorities. For this reason, the following attendance requirements will be in effect for students who participate in extracurricular activities:

A student will be in class a minimum of four (4) class periods the day of an activity or the student may be considered ineligible to participate in any activity on the same day.

Exceptions include:

1. Medical appointments (doctor note required from that day's appointment)
2. Funerals

Any student who has been given an excused absence or is absent because of school-sponsored activities will be permitted to make up the work missed. If a test is missed, it should be arranged to be taken before school, at noon, or at the convenience of the teacher. Students who were pulled out of class for special academic needs will hand in

STUDENT ATTENDANCE, REGULATION (Cont.)

required home work the next time that class meets. Students will be allowed one day to make up work for each day absent while participating in school-sponsored activities.

***LEGAL REFERENCE:** 38 O.S. §37

LEGAL NOTE: The district's enumerated listing of excused absences does not match that set in statute at 70 O.S. Section 10-105. It is strongly encouraged that the district's listing be updated accordingly.

In addition, the phrase "extenuating circumstances deemed necessary by the principal" creates a subjective standard that does not give parents or students notice as to what would qualify as an extenuating circumstance. This could be utilized against the district in litigation if a challenge were made with regard to the absences of a student.

Likewise, the phrase "student's will be in a class a minimum of four class periods the day of an activity or the student may be considered ineligible to participate in any activity on the same day" could lead to challenges and/or public relations issues for the school district in that the use of the word "may" allows the administration to make potentially arbitrary and capricious decisions. The policy should either require attendance four periods a day or not. The same problem as addressed above exists with the possible exceptions language.

The district's policy continues to mandate the use of doctor's notes for medical absences. Do know that this creates potential equity issues for the school district in that student may not have access to health care and that could lead to a disparate impact upon students. This language would potentially compel students to come to school ill rather than face attendance issues which could then lead to additional illness/sickness within the school community.

The regulation does not contain any information on chronic absenteeism. That should be included within this policy.
