b. Building Handbook Amendment

Description: Approve the following amendment to the building handbooks:

TOBACCO AND NICOTINE PRODUCTS

The use, possession, distribution, or sale of tobacco, nicotine, vaping devices, e-cigarettes, or related products by students is prohibited on school property, at school-sponsored events, and in school vehicles.

First Offense

For a student's first violation involving the use or possession of tobacco or nicotine products:

- A school staff member will meet with the student to discuss the incident and provide education regarding the health risks associated with tobacco, nicotine, and vaping products.
- Educational resources may include access to online materials on vaping prevention and awareness. The student will be offered support and information regarding cessation resources.
- School administration will review the circumstances of the violation and determine whether disciplinary consequences (excluding suspension or expulsion) are warranted.

The district's goal is to educate students, promote healthy choices, and provide support to students seeking to discontinue the use of tobacco and nicotine products.
