

Hi Tami,

That's a good question. LOL I don't see the prices listed anywhere on there. I'll have to talk to my tech guy. Although when I go to my new program I should be able to update that myself. 😊

Anyway, our current prices are:

Breakfast @ all sites is 2.25 for paid students & 2.50 for All Adults, A La Carte (seconds &/or open.)

Lunch @ High School is 3.25, @ the Middle School and Elementarays it is 3.00 for paid students. For Adults and seconds it is 4.00. For Reduced students we follow the guidelines of .30 breakfast and .40 lunch prices.

These have been our prices for 2 years now. I haven't done the PLE yet because I requested the waiver since we qualified back in Dec. & Jan. Even though I got the waiver I will still go ahead and do the PLE when I have time to make sure that we are still on track with what we should be charging to stay in the black. Hope this helps. And as always if you have any other questions please feel free to contact me.
