## March 2026 DHB Report

March 5, 2026

DHB on 4<sup>th</sup> Grader

A DHB was requested by the parents after 4<sup>th</sup> Grader was assigned to TES Behavior Class for 6 weeks. Mr. Pillow presented the information detailing the infractions that lead to the student being placed in this class. The Board listened to the student, parents, and Mr. Pillow. The DHB also looked at the discipline referrals. Based on the information we received from all parties at the DHB, the Board believes that it is in the best interest of the student to uphold the 6-week placement in the Behavior Class with Mr. Greg Vinson. This was explained to the parents before they left the building on 3/6/2026.

March 12, 2026

DHB on 8<sup>th</sup> Grader

A DHB was requested by his mother after 8<sup>th</sup> Grader was assigned to TRMS Alternative School for the remainder of the school year. Mrs. Jessica Murray presented the information detailing the infractions that lead to the student being placed in Alternative School. The Board listened to the student, the mother, and Mrs. Murray. The DHB also looked at and discussed with all parties these discipline referrals. Based on the case presented, the Board believes that it is in the best interest of the student to uphold the placement to Alternative School for the remainder of the school year.

Several times during the DHB the mother mentioned that she felt it was important that the student be able to attend the after school tutoring program so that they could interact with teachers and get more help with their work.

The Board took this into consideration and decided to allow the student to come to ATSI tutoring for the remainder of the time it is offered, allowing the student to get the help that the mother requested. This was out of the norm, usually when someone is in alternative school they can not attend any functions at school. The Board spoke with Director Tim Haney and Special Populations Supervisor Amy Allen and explained our reasoning for allowing the student to participate in ATSI and to ask if they would grant us permission to extend this offering to the student. Director Haney agreed with the Board as did Supervisor Allen.

I called the mother and explained that the Board was upholding the Principal's decision to place the student in Alternative School for the remainder of the year, but that we were going to allow them to stay for ATSI tutoring until completion of the program. I explained that they would have to be picked up at 4:15 and was not allowed at any other functions at TRMS. I also explained that the Board did state that if they got into any trouble in the tutoring program they would be dismissed from that program and no longer allowed to attend.
