Dear Board Members:

Since you approved our Return-to-School plan at the July 13 Board meeting, the Administration has continued to follow developments with the Covid-19 pandemic. During the past month, the Oklahoma Department of Health has implemented a color-coded [Covid-19 Alert System](#). Using this system, the Oklahoma State Department of Education has issued a set of [school safety protocols](#). While the State Board of Education did not adopt these protocols as a mandate, we have been using them as a guideline for developing the recommendations that you will find below.

**Green (fewer than 1.43 new positive cases per day based on 100,000 residents)**

- The school district will provide traditional, in-person instruction for all students every day.
- The district recommends that all staff and students wear a mask at all times in district facilities, except for meal times.
- Schools will limit, but not prohibit visitors to school buildings.
- Schools will limit, but not prohibit, schoolwide assemblies.

**Yellow (more than 1.43 but fewer than 14.39 new positive cases per day based on 100,000 residents)**

- The school district will provide traditional, in-person instruction for all students every day.
- The district requires that all staff and students wear a mask at all times in district facilities, except for meal times.
- Schools will not allow visitors to enter the building past the front office area.
- Schools will not hold schoolwide assemblies.

**Orange (more than 14.39 new positive cases per day based on 100,000 residents)**

- The school district will provide instruction every day of the academic calendar, but students will attend in-person on an alternating basis, using an A/B schedule. Students on the A schedule will attend on Mondays and Tuesdays. Students on the B schedule will attend on Thursdays and Fridays. Students will attend in person on Wednesdays on an alternating basis.
- The district requires that all staff and students wear a mask at all times in district facilities, except for meal times.
- Schools will not allow visitors to enter the building past the front office area.
- Schools will not hold schoolwide assemblies.

**Red (more than 14.39 new positive cases per day based on 100,000 residents, plus additional gates triggered)**

- The school district will provide instruction every day of the academic calendar, but students will be working remotely.
- The district requires that all staff and students wear a mask at all times in district facilities, except for meal times.

Mid-Del Schools will follow the designation made for Oklahoma County in making decisions for the district. Every effort will be made to plan for a month at a time and to provide families with as much notification as possible.

The school district, to the greatest extent possible, will monitor local data, in addition to the county and state data that determines the status of our school district under the alert system. If local data significantly differs from county data, the district may choose to move to a different alert level. Additionally, any disruption to the availability of PPE could trigger a decision to move the district to a different color.


Students with disabilities or who have documented medical conditions that prevent them from wearing a mask will be exempted from the requirement. In these cases, teachers will be provided with a face shield in addition to a school-provided neck gaiter.

At the school sites, IEP teams will review plans for students who may need to come to school five days a week. In the case that Oklahoma County is in either the Orange or Red designation, we will have predetermined which students will still require a full week of traditional, in-person instruction.

Since these adjustments will require significant preparation, we are also recommending that the first day of school be pushed back to August 24, and that we begin the school year under the orange designation. At this time, we would plan to remain on the alternating A/B schedule until at least September 25.

We ask you to approve these changes to the district's Return-to-Learn plan.
