3. other officers and committees the board considers necessary.

Specifically, PAISD Board Policy BDAA (LOCAL) states,

Board Officers: The Board shall elect a President, a Vice President, and a Secretary who shall be members of the Board. The Board may assign a District employee to provide clerical assistance to the Board. Officers shall be elected by majority vote of the members present and voting.

Terms and Duties: Board officers shall serve for a term of one year or until a successor is elected. Officers may succeed themselves in office. Each officer shall perform any legal duties of the office and other duties as required by action of the Board.

TASB Board Nomination

ACTION ITEM:

The TASB Board of Directors is charged with carrying out directives established by the Delegates at the Delegate Assembly. In addition, the Director will be asked to serve on a standing committee that will meet, as needed, in conjunction with Board meetings. The Director should be a capable, experienced school board member who can assist in providing the Association with outstanding leadership.

The position is currently held by Kristi Littleton (Port Aransas ISD). Littleton has indicated that she will be seeking reelection. The term of this position is for two years beginning at the close of the 2026 TASA | TASB Convention and expiring after Convention 2028.

RECOMMENDATION:	Accept the superintendent's recommendation to nominate PAISD Board President Kristi Littleton for the Region 2 seat on the TASB Board of Directors.

Consider/Take Possible Action to Approve Innovative Course at Port Aransas High School: Sports Medicine II, N1150041 (SPORTMD2).

Action Item:

The Texas Education Agency has a process where innovative courses can be designed and submitted for approval by school districts. Once approved, other school districts can offer the course for high school credit if approved by the school board.

WHEREAS the Parties desire to enter an understanding, this setting out all necessary working arrangements that both Parties agree shall be necessary

MISSION

The mission of this agreement is to work together to provide a safe place to offer a variety of activities including games, sports, arts and crafts, drama, play time, physical fitness, and more. We strive to encourage motor skill development, and social development, promote education, build self-esteem, fight childhood obesity, and most of all provide a fun environment where we; “Encourage Curiosity, Inspire Imagination and Strengthen Bodies”.

PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The Parties acknowledge that no contractual relationship is created between them by this MOU, and agree to work together to ensure that a safe location is provided for the community youth programs.

SERVICES/COOPERATION

The services/cooperation for this MOU shall include:

City of Port Aransas

The City of Port Aransas will make available at no cost the City’s Youth Programs to PAISD Staff’s families dependents.

Marlin Academy After School Care

Hours: Weekdays, 3:30 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. (Hours per program may vary and are subject to change.)

Waived Fees Regular/Full Price

\$125 per month - 1st student, \$62.50 per month - Sibling(s)/Same Household

Camp Marlin (Summer and Day Camps)

Hours: Weekdays, 7:30 a.m.- 5:30 p.m. (Hours per program may vary and are subject to change.)

Waived Fees Regular/Full Price

\$200 per week - 1st Student, \$100 per week - Sibling(s)/Same Household

Port Aransas Independent School District

PAISD will provide access to the facilities required for the above services to be provided, The gymnasium, cafeteria, and the fine arts corridor that includes the music and art room. Space for

storage and light administration is also required. **Space availability may fluctuate due to maintenance or staff needs.**

When field trip days are organized PAISD will provide transportation, including a bus and **driver (to be paid hourly by COPA).**

TERMS OF UNDERSTANDING

The term of this MOU shall be for a period of one year from the effective date and may be extended upon written mutual agreement of both Parties.

AMENDMENT OR CANCELLATION OF THIS MEMORANDUM

This MOU may be amended or modified at any time in writing by mutual consent of both parties. In addition, the MOU may be canceled by either party with sixty days advance written notice, with the exception where the cause for cancellation may include, but is not limited to, a material and significant breach of any of the provisions contained herein, when it may be canceled upon delivery of written notice to the other party.

ASSIGNMENT

Neither party to the MOU may assign or transfer the responsibilities or agreement made herein without the prior written consent of the non-assigning party, whose approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.

AUTHORIZATION AND EXECUTION

The signing of this MOU does not constitute a formal undertaking, and as such it simply intends that the signatories shall strive to reach, to the best of their abilities, the goals and objectives stated in this MOU.

This agreement shall be signed by the City of Port Aransas and Port Aransas Independent School District and shall be effective as of the date first written above.
