Contract Extension Update

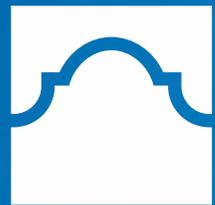
- Terms of new contract and budgeting structures remain undefined to date
- Alamo Collegiate Network leadership recommended acquisition of 1 year extension of current partnership agreement to maintain existing operational and budgeting processes until terms of new contract defined as long as the extension included a term to include full academic year 2025-2026

Contract Extension Update

- In March, Alamo Collegiate Network Board voted to recommend to the Alamo Colleges District board the approval of a 1-year extension of the SB 1882 Partnership with SAISD
- San Antonio Independent School District Board approved 1 year extension and provided a contract amendment with ending date of May 2026 which is set to go before Alamo Colleges District Board in August
