Location: MacArthur High School

Date: Session I: June 7 - June 29 (Mon.-Thurs.)

Cost: \$50 half credit course, maximum \$100
(Students may enroll in three ½ credits)

Courses: All core and advanced placement courses will be offered

Program Description: Allow students to gain or recover credit.

Program Description:

Special Education Extended School Year Program services are provided to eligible students with disabilities in accordance with guidelines issued by the Texas Education Agency (TEA). These services are necessary to meet student's educational needs as specified by the Admission, Review and Dismissal (ARD) committee in order to prevent significant regression in critical areas on the Individual Education Plan (IEP).
