Background Information:

Section 2.10.6 of the Financial Accountability System Resource Guide, version 14.0, dated January 2010, states that budget amendments are mandated by the state for budgeted funds reallocated from one function level, and state and/or federal project to another. These budget changes are usually the result of unexpected levels of expenditures in certain categories and must be amended in the budget for legal compliance.

All budget amendments are required to be adopted by the last day of the fiscal year. All necessary budget amendments must be formally adopted by the school board and recorded in the board minutes.

Fiscal Implication:

Because we have verbal approval to spend 80% of our Instructional Materials Allotment, the budget amendments from last month that included an increase to function 11 to cover HS and JH textbook purchases for the new school year is being transferred to Fund 410 from Fund 199. This month's amendments also include another reduction to state funding revenue by \$110,000 and local revenue by \$106,000. Expenditure budget is increased in function 34 for transportation costs by \$35,000 and decreased in function 11 by \$200,000. Child Nutrition expenditure budget is amended by \$56,000 to cover payroll costs.

The personnel department, campus principals, and management teams interview and check references on each applicant who makes application to become a member of the staff of the La Vega Independent School District. The Board of Trustees must approve revisions to the LVISD Job Description Manual.
