

Bowie Junior High Board Report ***January Enrollment By Grade***

6th = 110 7th= 130 8th= 102 Total= 341

Students demonstrated strong academic growth during the Middle of the Year (MOY) NWEA/MAP assessments in Reading and Math, showing consistent progress across all grade levels. In sixth grade, about 70% of students demonstrated growth in Reading (69.72%) and Math (70.64%). Seventh-grade students continued to make progress, with 63.64% demonstrating growth in Reading and 59.09% in Math. Eighth-grade students showed notable gains in Math (64.36%) and Reading (52.48%). These results reflect effective instructional practices and strong teacher commitment to the belief that all students are *our kids*. Teachers across content areas supported students in setting NWEA goals during 7th period, reinforcing shared responsibility for student success and strengthening student ownership of learning.

The pre-athletics program curriculum was revisited, and coaches committed to providing more structured, sport-specific instruction rather than general physical education. Students have responded positively, and this approach is expected to strengthen foundational skills in both girls' and boys' athletics, better preparing them for competitive success.

January and early February are busy months on campus, with basketball tournaments, end-of-season district tournaments, and preparations for the first junior high track meet. Our band and choir are preparing for their upcoming solo and ensemble contests. Recognition events include Counselor Appreciation Week (February 2–6), SRO Appreciation Day (February 16), and Career and Technical Education Month. Additionally, DIT and CIT committees will meet for MOY assessments. Testing begins with our RLA Mock STAAR test on January 27, followed by multiple assessments. These assessments include standalone eighth-grade RLA field-test mock assessments in RLA, Science, and Social Studies before the next board meeting, with the Math mock test the day after. Students will also have the opportunity to attend the Valentine's Dance sponsored by PASS, and sixth- and eighth-grade students will complete Stop the Bleed training, with eighth-grade students completing their training the day after the board meeting.

Overall, Bowie Junior High continues to see meaningful growth academically, athletically, and through extracurricular engagement, reflecting the dedication of teachers, coaches, and staff in supporting every student.

ENROLLMENT: 427 Fightin' Jackrabbits!

UPDATE:

*We had 233 Jackrabbits who either earned all A's or all A's and B's for the second quarter!

*We had 59 total FFA members participate in the county show sale. We had 9 Grand Champion winners, 4 Reserve Grand Champion winners, and 3 Showmanship winners. We had 19 students who made sale, winning \$16,400, not including add-ons. We also had 16 students participate in 4 events on Leadership Day, including the BBQ competition, public speaking, etc.

*Out of the 39 students who retook an End of Course exam in December (i.e., Algebra I, English I, Biology, English II, US History), 16 students passed at least one of their assessments, as some students had more than 1 to retake. We had 3 students from ALA who took an EOC for the first time and all 3 passed!

*Senior Next Steps Night will be Thursday, January 29th at 5pm. We will share local scholarships, finalize graduation requirements, FAFSA support, and what to expect this spring for the Class of 2026. Parents and seniors are all highly encouraged to attend.

Athletic Director Report

Boys Basketball currently stands at 11–14 overall and 1–3 in district play. The team earned a huge road win at Vernon on Tuesday night and looks to use that victory to build momentum moving forward. Senior Rayder Mann surpassed 1,000 career points, a tremendous milestone and an achievement our entire program is proud of.

Girls Basketball is 15–11 on the season and 2–3 in district play. They are coming off an impressive 33-point win on Tuesday night and, like the boys, are looking to carry that momentum into some important upcoming games. Both basketball teams have big matchups ahead as district play continues.

Tennis begins their spring season with tournaments at Denton Ryan and Fort Worth Northside. Powerlifting opens its season tonight in Muenster, with 19 lifters competing. We are excited to see their hard work pay off this year.

Softball began practices last week and will scrimmage Wichita Falls Legacy on Saturday. Baseball officially starts practice on Friday. Track season kicks off today as well.

Coach Price has been conducting mid-year meetings with coaches over the past two weeks. These meetings are focused on formally checking the pulse of each program by discussing what is going well, areas that may need improvement, and identifying any challenges coaches are currently facing. Coach Price is also using this time to discuss future plans, both within BISD and in each coach's professional career. These conversations have been productive and valuable as we continue to support our coaches and strengthen our athletic programs.

It is a very busy and exciting time of year for our athletic programs, and we are looking forward to a great spring season.
