FACILITIES UPDATE

July 21, 2021

- Reroof at DBHS had been delayed. The contractor was waiting for the screws and plates to attach the roof decking. He has received half his order and will continue work.
- Gray brick repair is essentially complete. Doing some tuck pointing and finishing repair of dumpster enclosure.
- Bleacher installation at Gray is complete. Installer is at DBHS. Once DBHS is complete he will move to DCHS.
- BCE floor replacement should be completed by 7/ 23. Waxing has begun on several wings.
- Lamar awnings are partially complete. They will be onsite to pick up the last frame and cover it.
- Portable buildings have been split and wrapped for transport. They should be gone by end or middle of next week.
- Ionization contract is in circulation for signatures. Work to begin after all signatures are collected.
- Lighting study has been completed by Excel Energy Group. Application has been made top EESI.
- Practice football field at DCHS is in process.
- Rogers Wildlife to begin work on back wing at Lamar on the 29th to prevent bats from entering the attic.
- Water entered the gym backdoor at SC. This occurred on or about the 28th of June. The amount of water did not look to be very much when we found it. We proceeded to place fans and remove base to dry the floor to no avail. The insurance company has been contacted and a claim number has been assigned. We are awaiting a call from Prater Flooring on estimates to repair and or replace part of the floor. Steps are being taken, on the drainage problem area, to prevent this from happening in the future.
- A computer board for the chiller at DCHS is scheduled to arrive August 9. A temporary chiller is to arrive Thursday the 22nd and should be up and

running by the end of the day. JCI is confident this last computer board will make the chiller run.

- Prep work has begun to repaint the ROTC building at DCHS.
- Demolition of the walls at the former BCMS is complete. The contractor is now hauling away the debris and will then begin to remove basement walls and footings.
