**RESOLUTION CANVASSING RETURNS
OF THE MAY 3, 2025 CITY GENERAL AND SPECIAL
ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Town of Horizon City ordered a general election to be held in said City on May 3 , 2025, for the purpose of electing the following named City officials for the terms as established by and in accordance with the Charter of the Town of Horizon City: City Council members, Places 1, 2, 4, and 6;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Town of Horizon City also ordered a special election be held on May 3, 2025, for the purpose of reauthorization of the local sales and use tax at the rate of one fourth (1/4) of 1% percent to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets (Proposition “A”) and filling the vacancy in Place 5; and

WHEREAS, both elections were held and the officers responsible for conducting the election have properly prepared the returns of the results and said returns have been delivered to said City Council.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF HORIZON CITY:**

1. That the City Council officially finds and determines that the election was duly ordered, that proper notice of the election was duly given, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to the election, that the election was duly held, that due returns of the results of the election have been duly made and delivered, that the election returns have been properly made out and duly certified by the officers of the election in the different voting precincts of the City, and that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with the law.
