RESOLUTION

Executive (Closed) Session

RESOLVED, By the School Board of Independent School District 709, St. Louis County, Minnesota, that the School Board shall meet in Executive (Closed) Session on Tuesday, October 18, 2011 at approximately 6:00 p.m. in the Board Conference Room of the Historic Old Central High School for the purpose of discussing private educational data relating to a possible student expulsion, conducted pursuant to MN Statute 13D.05 Subd. 2(3)

Resolution E-10-11-2940

Member Wasson introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION EXPELLING A STUDENT

WHEREAS, written notice of intent to expel a student attending Woodland Middle School was served upon the student and the student's parents;

WHEREAS, the notice of intent to expel the student complied with the provisions of the Pupil Fair Dismissal Act, Minn. Stat. § 121A.47, subd. 2;

WHEREAS, the student and the student's parent waived their right to a hearing on the proposed expulsion in writing; and

WHEREAS, under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, the waiver of right to an expulsion hearing and the name of the student proposed for expulsion are private data.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The School Board hereby accepts the waiver and expels the student from the schools of Independent School District No. 709, Duluth, for one full year (12 months) from October 18, 2011 through October 18, 2012.
2. The Superintendent, or his designee, is directed to mail to the student and the student's parent a copy of this Resolution along with a letter stating that the student has been expelled and that the student has the right to reenroll in the District on October 19, 2012.
3. The Superintendent, or his designee, is directed to identify the alternative educational services that are available to the student during the period of expulsion, if the student wishes to take advantage of them.
4. The Superintendent, or his designee, is directed to make an electronic report of this expulsion to the Commissioner of the Department of Education within thirty (30) calendar days, as required by Minn. Stat. §121A.53.

Member Kasper seconded the foregoing Resolution and upon a vote being taken thereon, the following voted in favor thereof: Glass, Grover, Johnston, Kasper, Seliga Punyko, Wasson
