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RESOLUTION EXPELLING A STUDENT

WHEREAS, written notice of the proposed expulsion of a student was served upon the student and the student's parent in compliance with the Minnesota Pupil Fair Dismissal Act;

WHEREAS, the School Board reviewed written Findings of Fact and Conclusions regarding the proposed expulsion; and

WHEREAS, the written notice of the proposed expulsion, the name of the student proposed for expulsion, and the Findings of Fact and Conclusions are private educational data under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The School Board hereby accepts and adopts the Findings of Fact and Conclusions as the basis for its decision.
2. The School Board hereby expels the student from Independent School District No. 709, Duluth Public Schools, for a period of twelve (12) calendar months.
3. The Assistant Superintendent, or his designee, is directed to mail the following to the student and to the student's parent: a copy of this Resolution; a copy of the Findings of Fact and Conclusions; and a letter stating that the student has been expelled effective October 13, 2021, and may apply for enrollment effective October 13, 2022.
4. The Assistant Superintendent, or his designee, is directed to identify the alternative educational services that are available to the student during the period of expulsion, if the student wishes to take advantage of them.
5. The Assistant Superintendent, or his designee, is directed to make an electronic report of this expulsion to the Commissioner of the Minnesota Department of Education within thirty calendar days as required by Minnesota Statutes section 121A.53.
