Director's Report: started baseball and softball games last Saturday

Fields are active and in use

Riptide Tournament was played fully, second was rained out, Sunday was cancelled due to wet fields.

Hired April 6th a new pool manager Tea. Aquatic center will be filled up this Wednesday May 6th.

First Aid and CPR training with lifeguards happening now at our pool.

All are on track to be certified before pool opens Memorial Weekend May 23rd.

New chairs are coming, new lane lines, life jackets vests that are Red Cross approved.

Plumbing repairs for bath house.

Deck expansion did not pass council approval.

Discussion of extra parking spaces into the green space.

Field 1 Wayne Park bathrooms are not going to be open. Porta johns are available. Possible removal of building in the near future. Concessions aren't needed. Pad will stay in place for future building replacement.

Lawson Park has new top dressing on all baseball fields.

Toilets are fixed and ready for the season.

Planning to budget for renovating all the outfield lips, especially Field 3.

Adding more tournaments on the schedule for 2027.

Flag football for registration.

Flex pickleball league through the PickleHeads App; keeps the schedule for tournament.

Possible tennis league. Tennis court resurfacing will begin when overnight temps hold at 50*.

Should be done by the end of the month.

Basketball games, home run derby, dunk tank, kids' market, money dive all scheduled for July 4th.

Lawson Park and Aquatic Center Donor wall list has been sent to the sign maker. Proofs are forthcoming.

Verizon Wireless tower is approved for installation. Site evaluation is complete. Paying 5 years rent up front to be used for the fencing for the dog park.
