A meeting of the Bristol Board of Education School, Family and Community Partnership Committee was held on February 18, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board of Education Auditorium and via the Zoom Meeting Platform

PRESENT: Commissioner Barbara Tedesco, Kara Ledger and Jennifer Van Gorder; Chair Shelby Pons (Virtual)

ALSO, PRESENT: Deputy Superintendent Mary Hawk, Erika Treannie, Director of Climate, Culture & Student Services

1. Call to Order - Pledge of Allegiance

Commissioner Tedesco called meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and asked the audience to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance

2. Approval of Minutes - January 28, 2026 Regular SFCP Meeting Minutes

Commissioner Tedesco called for a motion to approve the January 28, 2026 Regular SFCP Meeting Minutes. The motion was made by Kara Ledger and seconded by Jennifer Van Gorder.

4.1 Dad's Up Front Program Presented by Mr. Morris Patton

Commissioner Tedesco welcomed Mr. Morris Patton who provided an overview of his program that is geared towards fathers of all ages. Mr. Patton's vision and mission is to restore the value of fatherhood so that every child has a present, loving, and nurturing father. Mr. Patton shared that on Saturday January 31, 2026 he held an event at the Boys and Girls club that it was an opportunity for fatherhood advocacy, support and networking. Mr. Patton

shared personal experiences since starting this program about fellow fathers and how he hopes to build the relationship with the education community to ensure that fathers are part of their students' lives and education processes.
