OFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE GREENVILLE CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION
Thursday, June 27, 2024

The Greeneville City Board of Education met in Regular session on Thursday, June 27, 2024, at the Greene Technology Center, 1121 Hal Henard Rd, Greeneville, Tennessee 37743. Board Members **Present:** Pam Botta (Board Member), Cindy Luttrell (Chair), Josh Quillen (Treasurer), Dr. Craig Shepherd (Vice-Chair). **Absent:** Crystal Hirschy (Board Member). Others in attendance included Steve Starnes, Director of Schools, several administrative personnel, community members, and media representatives. The Chair called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance.

- Adjusted the settings on Rm 48A to achieve more comfortable discharge air temperatures.
- Identified that the cafeteria unit return filter grilles required a custom order. Once CMTA receives the materials, they will be back onsite to install.
- Painted access panels.
- Ongoing testing and balancing were being conducted to optimize the system.

E. Consideration of Approving Beverage Vending Contract

The district beverage/vending contract with Pepsi will expire on June 30, 2024. A request for proposal was issued by GCS which resulted in the receiving of one proposal (Pepsi). A district team was selected to carefully evaluate the proposal and make a recommendation going forward. The team unanimously approved the Pepsi proposal. Pepsi is being recommended as the vendor-partner for GCS beverage/vending. The contract will begin on July 1, 2024, and will expire on June 30, 2027. However, RFP and contract verbiage includes provision for a maximum of two (1-year) contract extensions. If executed, the extensions could place contract expiration date on June 30, 2029. The proposed Pepsi proposal is attached to the minutes. Board approval was unanimous on approving Beverage Vending Contract.

F. Consideration of Approving School Trip Request

Board Policy 4.302 specifies that the Board must approve field trips that are both overnight and out-of-state. Additionally, approval is required when students must leave school early for participation in athletic events. Board approval was unanimous on approving the following trips:

- Greeneville High School Track Team requested approval to travel to Murfreesboro, TN to participate in the State Track Meet from 05/20/2024 - 05/22/2024. Executive Approval was granted on 05/15/2024.
- Greeneville High School Cheer Team requested approval to travel to Gatlinburg, TN to participate in a cheer camp from 07/08/2024 - 07/11/2024.
- Greeneville High School Volleyball Team requested approval to travel to Knoxville, TN to participate in a team camp at Johnson University from 07/19/2024 - 07/24/2024.

- Greeneville High School Cross Country Team requested approval to travel to Abingdon High School to participate in a team camp from 07/15/2024 - 07/16/2024.

G. Consideration of Approving 2024-2025 Paper Contract for District

GCS currently purchases approximately 750–850 cases of paper per year for use at all schools and business offices. This contract is negotiated on an annual basis.

Following the release of the request for proposals, three submissions were received. Staples is the recommended vendor/supplier. Supporting proposal documentation is attached to the minutes. Board approval was unanimous on approving 2024-2025 Paper Contract for District.

H. Consideration of Approving Highland Roof Deck Replacement Project

A section of roof over the academic section of Highland Elementary was damaged by a windstorm on Tuesday, November 21st. Insurance will pay to repair the 30' x 50' damaged section of the roof. Due to the age of the roof, the repair will require different materials than the surrounding area. Since the roof is already on our capital replacement list, the recommendation is to apply insurance funds toward completely replacing the entire roof with a 30-year warranty rather than just patching a 30' x 50' section.

The BOE approved a proposal from Morristown Roofing to replace the section during its January 2024 meeting. As the work began, it was discovered that the decking material installed in the 1970s was degraded and needed to be replaced. Original tests conducted prior to the bid process did not reveal the damage. However, once discovered, there is no choice but to replace the deck as part of the process. Morristown Roofing submitted a proposal for replacing the roof deck for a total of \$115,767.42. Supporting documentation is attached to the minutes. Due to the nature and scope of the work, the purchase order has been issued and the work is underway. The district utilized provisions made possible in Tennessee law and State Board of Education regulations allowing emergency purchases under

conditions such as these. Board approval was unanimous on approving Highland Roof Deck Replacement Project.

I. Consideration of Approving Final 2023-2024 General Purpose Budget Amendment

Budget Amendments are made as closely as possible to fiscal year end to more accurately reflect revenues, expenditures, and account categories. Attached to the minutes is the Final General Purpose School Fund Budget Amendment to be approved in the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year. The amendment moves 2023-2024 funding to the state-approved account codes needed to match final expenditure projections. Board approval was unanimous on approving Final 2023-2024 General Purpose Budget Amendment.

J. Consideration of Approving Fiscal Year 2024 Federal Projects Budget Amendment #6

Budget Amendments are made periodically throughout the year to more accurately reflect anticipated revenues, expenditures, timing of expenditures, and grant award allocations. Attached to the minutes is the sixth Federal Projects Budget Amendment to be approved in the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year. Board approval was unanimous on approving Fiscal Year 2024 Federal Projects Budget Amendment #6.

K. Consideration of Approving 2024-2025 Federal Projects Budget

Board approval was unanimous for acceptance of submitting the 2024-2025 Federal Projects Budget to the State of TN Department of Education. Board approval was unanimous on approving 2024-2025 Federal Projects Budget.

L. Consideration of Approving Carmen Cox Scholarship Recipients

The Greeneville City Board of Education serves as trustees for the Carmen Cox Scholarship Trust. The Trust was established in 1996 through a bequest from the estate of T. Elmer Cox in memory of his wife, Carmen Cox. The Trust exists to provide scholarship assistance for post-secondary education to outstanding business students in each of the high schools located in Greene County. A trustee appointed

committee determines scholarship amounts and recipients annually. Applications were solicited from all five high schools located in Greene County. This is in accordance with Trust guidelines. The Board unanimously approved to award the following students with a one-time Carmen Cox Scholarship:

Budget Amendments are made periodically throughout the year to more accurately reflect anticipated revenues, expenditures, timing of expenditures, and grant award allocations. The second and final School Nutrition Budget Amendment to be approved in Fiscal Year 2023-2024 is attached to the minutes. Due to the specialized nature of the School Nutrition Program, it is recommended that any questions be submitted to the CFO prior to the Board meeting so that the proper information can be gathered. The Board unanimously approved the 2023-2024 School Nutrition Budget Amendment #2.

N. Consideration of Approving 2024-2025 School Nutrition Budget

The State of Tennessee requires approval of the School Nutrition Budget by the Board of Education. The financial position of the School Nutrition Program at GCS is very good. The Board unanimously approved the 2024-2025 School Nutrition Budget.

A. Consideration of Accepting May 2024 Financial Statements

Chief Financial Officer Ellen Lipe presented the May financial statements to the Board for acceptance. Lipe stated that local revenue collected year-to-date through

May 2024 is \$8,400,981, which is 92.2% of the total budgeted projection. The amount collected year-to-date is \$202,864 more than during the same time period last year. This reflects an actual percentage change of 2.47% compared to last year. The district has 590 tuition students as of June 19, 2024. The General-Purpose Financial Report showed that encumbrances comprise \$1,092,668 year-to-date. The Federal Projects Financial Reports reflected \$3,284,610.48 in revenue and \$3,729,583.63 in expenditures year-to-date. Federal Projects are reimbursed based, meaning funds must be expended before requesting reimbursement. Copies of the financial statements are on file in the Chief Financial Officer's office.

It was recommended to approve the May 2024 financial statements. Board approval was unanimous on a motion from Quillen (Treasurer) and a second from Dr. Shepherd (Vice-Chair).

B. Consideration of Approving 2024-2025 General Purpose Budget

The attached General Purpose School Fund Budget has been approved by the Greeneville City Council. The 2024-2025 General Purpose School Fund Budget presented reflects the latest information available at the time of budget document submission. The Budget is a culmination of a thorough and in-depth process. It reflects the Administration, Leadership Team, and the Board of Education's best efforts to address the needs of Greeneville City Schools and meet State and Federal requirements. The 2024-2025 General Purpose Budget is attached to the minutes. It was recommended to approve the 2024-2025 General Purpose Budget. Board approval was unanimous on a motion from Dr. Shepherd (Vice-Chair) and a second from Quillen (Treasurer).

E. Consideration of Approving Insurance Coverage for 2024-2025 Year

The district consistently relies upon adequate and appropriate insurance coverage to protect district assets and human resources. Continuous analysis is critical to ensure neither gaps nor overlaps exist in district policies. The GCS District is a member of the PEPartners. PEPartners is a voluntary, cooperative organization established by

the cities and towns of the state for mutual assistance and improvement. PEPartners is focused on helping provide high-quality risk management services for municipalities and school districts. Our local broker for PEPartners is the McInturff, Milligan, & Brooks group located in Greeneville, Tennessee. GCS has a long-standing relationship with this firm, and the group continues to provide exemplary customer service and support to the district. The firm also worked with Tennessee Risk Management to secure a quotation for insurance services.

The supporting documentation provides details regarding quotations, policies, and overall coverage. The recommended insurance company for the 2024-2025 year is PEPartners. The following table depicts the costs for property, general liability, and workers' compensation coverage for both GCS and GTC.

It was recommended to approve Insurance Coverage for 2024-2025. Board approval was unanimous on a motion from Quillen (Treasurer) and a second from Dr. Shepherd (Vice-Chair).

F. Consideration of Approving Purchase of New Maintenance Van

A cyclical replacement of the GCS Operations vehicle fleet is necessary for the overall operations of the school district. The van currently scheduled for replacement is a 2010 Ford Econoline van with 179,979 miles. The vehicle recommended for purchase to replace the 2010 model will be a mid-top van with a ladder rack, interior shelving, material bins, and a steel bulkhead. A recommendation is made to accept the proposal (attached as supporting documentation), a mid-top 2024 Ford 2024, F350 with 60 month/100,000-mile powertrain warranty. Upon approval, the vehicle will be purchased from Ford of Murfreesboro via the Tennessee State Purchasing Contract for \$57,508.55. Funds are budgeted annually to replace one operational vehicle per year.

It was recommended to approve the Purchase of a New Maintenance Van. Board approval was unanimous on a motion from Botta (Board Member) and a second from Quillen (Treasurer).

G. Consideration of Approving EastView Elementary School CDC Classroom Restroom

In 2019, a CDC classroom was added at Eastview Elementary School. To better serve these students, a bathroom in the classroom is needed. Dave Wright was contracted to design the bathroom and create bid documents. The public was invited to bid on the project as stipulated by State law. One bid was submitted for the project by Hite Construction Company for \$58,400.53 The sole bid is being recommended for approval. Capital Budget funds will be utilized.

It was recommended to approve Eastview Elementary School CDC Classroom Restroom. Board approval was unanimous on a motion from Botta (Board Member) and a second from Dr. Shepherd (Vice-Chair).

X. Director's Report

Starnes informed, congratulated, and thanked the following:

1. Carmen Cox Scholarship recipients! He wished them all the best as they use these scholarships to continue their educational journey.
2. GCS teams that participated in the TSSAA Spring Fling. Congratulations to the GHS Boy's track team who were crowned the 2024 Class AA State Champions! Also, congratulations to the GHS Soccer team who finished as state runner-up in the Class AA State Championships. Additionally, congratulations to the GHS Baseball team on finishing third in the Class AAA State Championships. Congratulations to the GHS Girls Track Team on participating in the Class AA State Championships. GCS will recognize these teams at a future Board meeting.
3. Congratulations to our two retirees, Beverly and Suzanne. Starnes thanked them for their dedicated service to Greeneville City Schools. Their impact will be felt for many years to come.
4. Ellen and the finance team are working hard to close out the books and wrap up the 23-24 fiscal year. They do an exceptional job and he just wanted to recognize them.
5. Mr. Chuck Broyles on being named our new Chief Technology Officer! "GCS is excited to see Chuck transition into this new role within the district and is confident that under Chuck's leadership and with the support of his team, GCS will continue to deliver the level of excellence that we have grown accustomed to in our technology programs."

6. Shelia Newland, who coordinated the Summer Learning Camps, along with the site directors, teachers, instructional assistants, transportation department, food service department, custodians, and office support staff for their hard work to ensure that students had an outstanding learning experience. The Summer Learning Camps were offered at Hal Henard, GMS, and GHS and concluded last week.

7. Starnes recognized and thanked Daniel Myers, Angelia Rodriguez, and Thomas Eason for leading Greeneville's Promise. Greeneville's Promise is a longstanding summer enrichment program for selected rising ninth graders.

8. The 23-24 TCAP Results were released on Monday afternoon. Starnes shared a copy of the press release regarding the results. The significant gains made across all content areas are the direct result of the hard work of our outstanding teachers, the focused effort of our students, and the support from our instructional team. He thanked and commended GCS teachers for their dedication to serving students in an extraordinary way. Starnes stated that he looked forward to further data releases from the Tennessee Department of Education, so they may have a complete picture of student growth and achievement to inform instructional planning moving forward.

9. Starnes wished everyone a wonderful 4th of July holiday and encouraged them to enjoy their time with family and friends!

XI. Director of Schools' Evaluation

Prior to adjournment, Chair Luttrell thanked the other board members for their participation and feedback on Mr. Starnes' evaluation this year. Conducting a superintendent evaluation serves as a tool to enhance performance and is a key component of our board's Board of Distinction checklist. The evaluation was based on performance regarding board goals, board relationships, community relationships, staff and personnel relationships, and educational characteristics. She stated that I met with Mr. Starnes on June 20th to discuss his evaluation and I am pleased to report that it was a very positive evaluation. Despite the increasing challenges in education each year, there was a consistent vote of confidence in his leadership, underscored by his active involvement on state committees and high regard among his peers.

Mr. Starnes demonstrates a steadfast commitment of time and energy to our system daily. His advocacy for public education and its funding, his proactive approach to adapting to new laws, regulations, and funding formulas, and his consistently strong personal ratings all contributed to his excellent evaluation. We are enthusiastic about his plans to support

our two new assistant directors in the upcoming year, as well as his efforts in managing the transition away from our partnership with Greene County Schools regarding the Greene Technology Center. Additionally, we look forward to continuing to collaborate with our Mayor and City Council on facility planning for Greeneville City Schools.

On May 24, 2017, the State Board of Education passed the new Strategic Compensation Policy which provides greater clarity on the qualifications for differentiated pay plans. 1 No later than the end of the school year, the Board will adopt, upon the recommendation of the
2 Director of Schools, an official school calendar for the succeeding school year. The calendar will
3 identify holidays, vacation days, summer sessions, and other extensions of the school year. The
4 calendar may be revised by the Board, upon recommendation of the Director of Schools, due to
5 inclement weather or other factors.

6 The regular school year shall be 200 days¹ and scheduled as follows:

- 7 • A minimum of 180 student attendance days;
- 8 • A minimum of five (5) days in-service education for all certificated personnel;
- 9 • One (1) day for parent-teacher conferences;
- 10 • Ten (10) days paid vacation for all certified personnel;
- 11 • Four (4) discretionary days; and
- 12 • **Schools will be closed for students on days when primary and general elections are held.**²

13 The calendar shall be distributed to the school staff at the opening of the school term.

14 **STUDENT ATTENDANCE DAYS**

15 When schools are closed due to emergencies or unforeseen circumstances such as epidemics or
16 inclement weather, the time lost shall be made up to the required minimum unless otherwise approved
17 by the State Department of Education.¹

18 **IN-SERVICE EDUCATION**

19 Each day of in-service education included in the school calendar shall be equivalent to not less than six
20 (6) hours of planned activities.³

21 **DISCRETIONARY DAYS**

22 Four (4) discretionary days shall be included in the calendar and may be designated by the Board as
23 student attendance days, in-service days, or administrative days which may be used by administrators,
24 faculty, and staff for preparation for commencement of classes, record keeping, grading examinations,
25 parent-teacher conferences, and other classroom functions.¹

11. Fail to promptly leave school property upon being directed to do so by school administration or law enforcement.
12. Possess, consume, sell, distribute, or exchange alcoholic beverages, tobacco, vaping products, or illegal drugs.
13. Possess or use firearms or dangerous weapons, except in the case of law enforcement officers.
14. Gamble or encourage another or others to gamble.
15. Violate any applicable federal or state statute, local ordinance, or board policy.

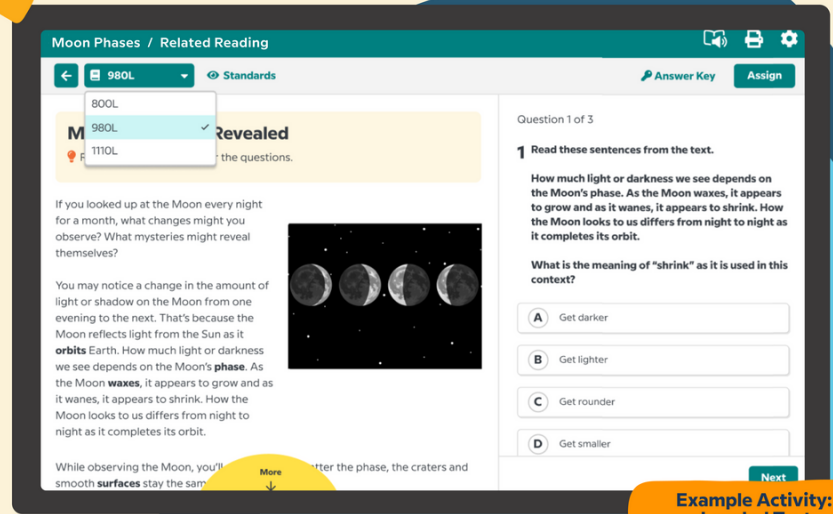

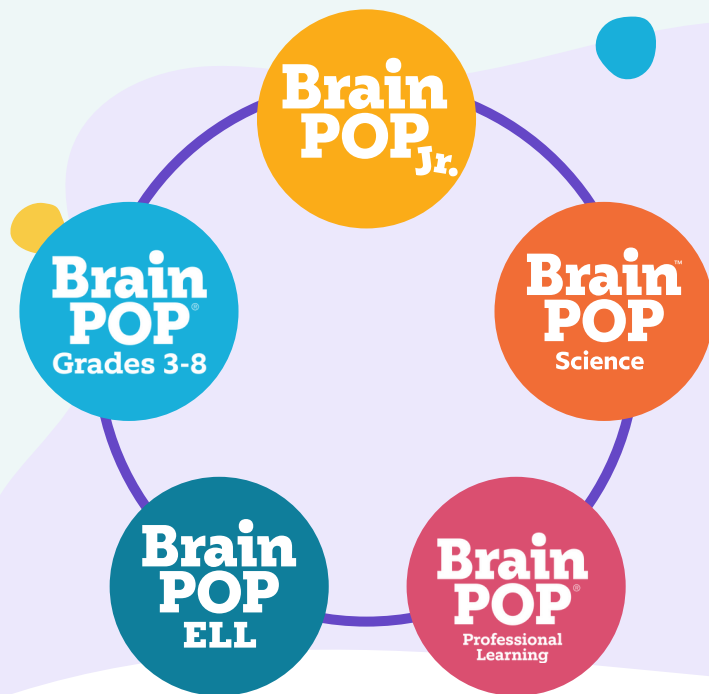
