Interlocal Agreement

Between Platte County and _____ Township

This Agreement has been entered into by and between _____ Township (hereinafter referred to as "Township") and the County of Platte (hereinafter referred to as "County"), both being political subdivisions of the State of Nebraska, in accordance with the provisions of the Interlocal Cooperation Act (Neb. Rev. §13-801, et sec.).

Recitals

WHEREAS this Agreement supersedes and replaces any prior agreements between Township and County pertaining to the topic discussed herein. This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement of the parties. This Agreement may be amended only by a written amendment, fully executed by both parties.

WHEREAS a map of Township system roads, mail route roads, and non-mail route roads to be maintained is attached hereto and incorporated by this reference. All sections are located in Township and are included on the attached map hereinafter referred to as Exhibit "A". Platte County system roads are as shown in the legend.

WHEREAS it is understood that proper maintenance of the County and Township roads is of the utmost priority for the safety of Platte County residents.

Authority & Purpose

Article XV, Section 18 of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska and the Interlocal Cooperation Act of the State of Nebraska, Neb. Rev. §13-801 et seq., (the "Act"), authorize any two or more public agencies to enter into agreements for joint or cooperative exercise of any power, privilege, or authority exercised or capable of exercise individually by such public agencies. The purpose of this agreement is to outline County System and Township System Roads and to provide clear guidelines for responsibilities related to the maintenance of each.

Agreements

County is responsible for all Platte County System Road maintenance which includes; routine blading, snow removal, drainage structures (ditches, culverts, and bridges), signing, gravel, and tree removal.

Township is responsible for maintenance of all Township Roads (as shown on Exhibit "A," attached hereto), which includes mail route roads [roads assigned specific county road numbers], non-mail route roads, and subdivision roads. Maintenance includes routine blading, snow removal, drainage structures under 48" in diameter, ditch cleaning, tree removal, and gravel.

Interlocal Agreement

Between Platte County and _____ Township

County will provide installation of culverts on Township roads for culverts under 48" if Township provides the culverts at their expense, has the culvert(s) delivered on site and reimburses the County for the actual cost of installation. County will provide installation of all drainage structures including culverts 48" and larger, bridges, provide and maintain regulatory and informational signage.

Failure of Township to maintain maintenance and upkeep may lead to an investigation of deficiencies by the County Highway Superintendent. In the event an issue is determined to exist by County Highway Superintendent a written explanation of said deficiency and deadline to correct shall be provided to Township. If Township fails to take corrective action County will provide manpower and equipment to correct and Township shall be responsible for payment of all costs to include, but not be limited to, labor, equipment, and materials.

County shall provide Township an allotment for gravel on mail route roads of _____ () per fiscal year of County (July 1st through June 30th). Any balance remaining in the allotment shall be carried forward and deducted from any future year's allotment.

- Township shall provide a statement to County outlining the use of said allotment 15 (fifteen) days prior to the close of County's fiscal year. The statement must include copies of the invoices paid by Township to a gravel supplier and must clearly indicate the county road number(s) where the gravel was placed.
- Township may contract for gravel and delivery with any licensed supplier.
- If Township contracts with County for gravel and delivery on mail route, non-mail route roads or within subdivisions, Township agrees to reimburse County for actual costs of labor, equipment and materials.

In the event Township require assistance from County for either equipment or manpower, Township agrees to reimburse County at the hourly rate and/or equipment rates established by the County Board of Supervisors at the beginning of each fiscal year. Requests for assistance must be made directly by a member of the Board for Township to the County Highway Superintendent.

Duration, Modification & Termination:

This Agreement may be terminated by either party with 30 days' written notice from either entity. The Agreement shall be for a term of (1) one year and shall renew annually absent either party providing written notice to the contrary.

Indemnification

Each governmental entity that is a party to this agreement agrees to indemnify and hold harmless, protect and defend the other as well as its elected and appointed officials, employees and representatives against any and all claims, demands, suits, actions, payments and judgments, including any and all costs and expenses connected therewith, for damages asserted, claimed or recovered against the other or its insurers, because of personal injury or death, or on account of property damage, in any way connected with or resulting from the work associated with this agreement.

Insurance

Each governmental entity shall maintain general liability insurance coverage of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 annual aggregate covering personal injury, including bodily injury and property damage involved with this agreement. Each party will carry automobile liability limits of not less than \$1,000,000 single limit. Each party will maintain responsibility for providing its workers with workers' compensation coverage and for any claims associated with its employees. "Certificate of Liability" Insurance shall be filed with the Platte County Highway Superintendent on 1st of January, of each year.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Agreement as of the date indicated.
