The bid opening for Wayzata Public Schools 2013 Flooring Replacement was held at the Administration Building on April 11, 2013 at 10:30 AM.

The scope of the project includes:

- Birchview: one classroom pod
- Gleason Lake: four kindergarten and one standard classrooms and the Home Base room
- Kimberly Lane: eight classrooms
- Plymouth Creek: twelve classrooms and alternate #6 includes five small special education classrooms
- West Middle School: nine classrooms
- Wayzata High School: first floor office area and alternate #10 & #11 are two corridors on first floor

Target Commercial Interiors submitted the lowest base bid for items #1-6 in the amount of \$187,040 and \$2,705 for Alternate No. 6, \$10,225 for Alternate No. 10 and \$10,015 for Alternate No. 11. Total bid award is \$209,985.

This bid in on budget and will be funded with Alternative Facilities.

We request that the following recommendation be presented to the School Board for the award of the Wayzata Central Middle School Operable Wall Replacement project.

On April 11, 2013, four (4) bids were received for the Wayzata Central Middle School Operable Wall Replacement project. A copy of the bid tabulation is enclosed for your review. The bids were received as four different base bids based on four different operable wall manufactures' products. This was done in order to maintain competition between operable wall suppliers. While there are minor differences between the panels, all would perform in the gymnasium. All of the bids received are within the budget established for the project and reflect fair value for the project.

The scope of the project includes replacing the existing deteriorated operable wall in the gymnasium at Central Middle School and is scheduled for construction this summer.

The following are our recommendation for the four base bids. The costs shown reflect the low bid as submitted:
