Minnesota Statutes, Section 128C.01, requires individual School Boards each year to authorize membership in the Minnesota State High School League. The Resolution for Membership affirms (1) that the Board of Education delegates the control, supervision, and regulation of League-sponsored athletic and fine arts activities to the Minnesota State High School League; (2) that the Board of Education adopts the Constitution, Bylaws and Rules and Regulations of the League; and (3) that the administration for and the responsibility for supervising the activities are assigned to the official representative. Ms. Sue Droegemueller is the appointed School Board representative to the Minnesota State High School League, and Jaime Sherwood, Activities and Athletic Director, is the Wayzata High School representative. The enclosed resolution provides for the appropriate School Board action.
