The St. Paul School Board met in regular session on December 12, 2016 at 7:30 PM. The following board members were in attendance: Daryl Anderson: Present, Shelly Hueftle: Present, Jason Meinecke: Absent, Janelle Morgan: Absent, Marty Mrkvicka: Present, Dan Scheer: Present, Kelvin Smith: Present, Ken Swinarski: Present.

The meeting was called to order at 7:33pm.

President Mrkvicka noted that notice of the meeting was published in the Phonograph Herald.

President Mrkvicka noted that the Open Meetings Law is posted on the wall of the meeting room.

President Mrkvicka asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes of the previous meeting. None were made, and the minutes were declared approved.

There were 4 students optioning in to the district and no students optioning out this month.

Rick Peters updated the Board on the ReVision process. Coaches evaluations have been completed. Mrs. Hagen and the Board discussed patron conduct at extracurricular activities. Howard County Community Hospital has worked with Mrs. Schulte on physician availability to sign paperwork for students receiving therapy services in school. The Board was given information regarding curriculum, assessment, and professional development.

Supt. Poppert gave a brief report on policy revision. He updated the Board on future changes for funding the state's retirement fund for teachers. He talked about the Legislative Conference and the State deficit and a likely decrease in school funding in the future. He elaborated on the ReVision grant and the possibility of having community members come to school and discuss careers with students, and obtaining new equipment/facilities (sewing machines, plasma table, farm ground) to help students expand knowledge of careers. Bids are being taken on refinishing the main gym floor, to be completed this summer. Supt. Poppert presented plaques to Kelvin Smith and Daryl Anderson for their years of service to the Board and the School District.

Motion to enter into Executive Session for salary negotiations to protect the public interest, passed with a motion by Daryl Anderson and a second by Kelvin Smith.

Motion to pay, from the Depreciation Fund, to Betty Dietz in the amount of \$3,800 plus the District's 2008 school bus, in exchange for a 2002 International 300 series school bus, passed with a motion by Marty Mrkvicka and a second by Daryl Anderson. Roll call vote: Anderson – AYE; Mrkvicka – AYE; Scheer – AYE; Smith – AYE; Swinarski – AYE.

Mrs. Paider and Mrs. Hagen reported on school improvement, staff development, curriculum, assessments, and other activities occurring throughout the school. Mr. Peters reported on the new scoreboard and athletic programs, and Mrs. Schulte reported on Special Education reports that she is working on.

The Building Committee updated the Board on plans for the elementary playground.

In the Superintendent's report, Mr. Poppert discussed plans to leave for the State Convention, and the septic tank bill. He discussed the option of purchasing a new or used bus.
