

## **Regular Meeting of the St. Paul Board of Education**

The St. Paul School Board met in regular session on March 8, 2021 at 6:00 PM. The following board members were in attendance: Shelly Hueftle: Present, Jason Meinecke: Absent, Janelle Morgan: Present, Marty Mrkvicka: Present, Dan Scheer: Present, Philip Thede: Present.

The meeting was called to order at 6:03pm.

President Mrkvicka stated that notice of the meeting was properly published in the Phonograph Herald and/or in 3 public places, per policy.

President Mrkvicka noted that the Open Meetings Law is posted on the wall of the meeting room.

Darin, Cleve and Brian from BVH were present to continue discussions of the options for for the 3 story building, including demolishing it and building new, vs a hybrid solution involving remodeling the 3 story building plus adding on to the current building. Jason Meinecke joined the meeting at 6:08pm.

The priorities of the Board were: having a building that could last 50-100 years; leaving the preschool at the Heritage building; creating a new Elementary entrance; and creating a modern, main entrance with a cafeteria/commons area, increasing the size of the cafeteria; and possibly remodeling/upgrading the kitchen. Some other ideas that came from brain-storming were improving the shop area, improving the Science rooms/labs, and consideration of a multi-purpose area that could also house a stage, etc., for the Performing Arts.
