

Regular Meeting of the St. Paul Board of Education

The St. Paul School Board met in regular session on May 27, 2014 at 7:00 PM. The following board members were in attendance: Daryl Anderson: Present, Suzan DeCamp: Present, Shelly Hueftle: Present, Marty Mrkvicka: Present, Dan Scheer: Present, Kelvin Smith: Present.

President Anderson called the meeting to order at 7:02pm.

President Anderson noted that notice of the meeting was published in the Phonograph Herald.

There were no communications from the public at this time.

The Board discussed the possibility of consolidating with Elba. A member of the public was present to make some comments about the possibility of consolidation, including the flow of traffic from Elba to St. Paul, and the safety of students. He was in favor of the consolidation. Another member of the public expressed concern about keeping an attendance center open in Elba, due to the cost of doing so. The Board talked at length about long term and short term problems vs benefits of a possible consolidation. Additional meetings will be scheduled as information is ascertained.
