Resolution providing for the issue of \$7,000,000 Taxable General Obligation School Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2021, of the District for the purpose of equipping school buildings and facilities of the District and improving the sites thereof, including but not limited to demolishing an existing building; providing for the pledge of certain revenues to the payment of principal and interest on said bonds; and providing for the levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to pay such principal and interest if the pledged revenues are insufficient to make such payment and authorizing the sale of said bonds to the Trustees of Schools of Niles Township.

6. Closed Session

It is recommended that the Board move into closed session to consider information regarding the appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance, or dismissal of specific employees of the public body or legal counsel for the public body, including hearing testimony on a complaint lodged against an employee of the public body or against legal counsel for the public body to determine its validity.
