Brief explanation for the board of the "guardian" life insurance policy

Life insurance for "guardian" (anyone who carries or is assigned as "safety" personnel).
It is an additional \$2.40 (district pays) per employee for \$50,000.00 coverage per employee - this is in addition to the \$10,000.00 policy that the school provides @ \$.48 per employee.
These employees would have a total coverage of a \$60,000.00 life insurance policy.
The amount the district would pay for these employees would be \$2.88 per employee.
The coverage for the employee covered by this life insurance is for **on or off the job**.
