### **Athletics:**

We are rolling strong and staying very busy. Spring is always a crazy time of year as we adjust schedules for the many events our students are involved in.

Basketball season has wrapped up, and we are now moving into **track, softball, baseball, golf, and tennis.**

### **Key notes from basketball season:**

We had the opportunity to host **five major playoff matchups** this season:

- **4A Division II:** Brock vs. Levelland (Girls)
- **2A Albany vs. 1A May** (Boys Warm-Up Game)
- **3A Division II:** Wall Lady Hawks vs. Tolar Lady Rattlers (*Wall went on to win State*)
- **5A Division II:** Argyle Lady Eagles vs. Lubbock Monterey Lady Plainsmen (*Argyle went on to win State*)
- **1A Division I:** Hamlin Pied Pipers vs. Water Valley Wildcats

We received **very high praise for our gym and the hospitality shown to teams and fans** throughout these events. In addition, our facility and game-day experience were highlighted on **social media by several major news outlets**, which was great recognition for our school and community.

### **Girls Basketball:**

High School girls basketball ended with a season record of **18-16**. (5 losses were within single digits.) We ended our season in the Bi-District Playoff round with a loss to **#4 Hermleigh**. Our girls received high praises from their administration and coaches on the improvement they have shown since playing them last season, as well as their attitude, effort, and character.

Junior High girls basketball A-Team ended up with a season record of **3-8**. Beating Ranger, Moran, and Perin-Whit.

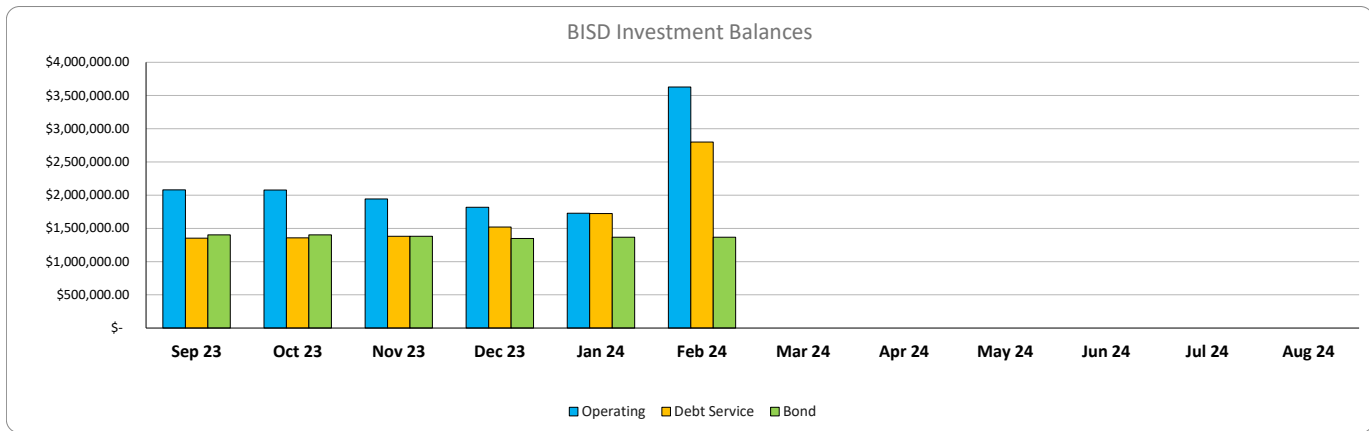

**SUBJECT:** Senate Bill 546 – Three-Point Seat Belt Compliance

### **Background**

Senate Bill 546, enacted during the 89th Texas Legislative Session, requires school buses operated by or contracted for use by a school district to be equipped with three-point seat belts for each passenger, including the operator. The bill eliminates a previous exception for buses that are model year 2017 or earlier. The Texas Education Agency has opened the compliance reporting period, with all submissions due no later than May 29, 2026.

Under SB 546, the seat belt requirement does not apply if the board of trustees determines that the district's budget does not permit compliance.

### **Current Fleet Status**

Baird ISD currently operates a fleet of buses requiring retrofit. The district has also ordered five new buses, which will be equipped with three-point seat belts as a standard feature upon delivery.

### **Cost Analysis**

The district obtained a quote from National Guaranteed Vinyl, Inc. for integrated seat belt installation on the existing fleet. The quote provides for installation of 136 three-point seat belt systems at \$980 per seat, for a total retrofit cost of \$133,280.

New buses on order are priced at \$162,336 per unit and include three-point seat belts as standard equipment.

### **Recommendation**

Administration recommends the board determine that the district's budget does not permit full compliance with SB 546 at this time. The five buses currently on order will include three-point seat belts as standard equipment. Two older buses will remain in service without seat belts until they are retired and replaced in the coming years.

### **Required Action**

If the board makes this determination, the district must submit a report to TEA through Sentinel no later than May 29, 2026. That submission must include this memo and the minutes from the March 23, 2026 meeting.


