6.2. Conduct Revenue Neutral Rate Hearing at 7:10 pm

Discussion: At 7:10 PM, the Board conducted the Revenue Neutral Rate Hearing. Mr. Davis went over the Revenue Neutral Tax Rate. District resident, Gilbert Hall presented some concerns about exceeding the revenue neutral rate. Mr. Davis provided answers to some of Mr. Hall's statements. Revenue Neutral Rate Resolution 2025-9 was then adopted by a roll-call vote. Ruth Slocum - Yea, Boone Smith - Yea, Ann Kelly - Yea, Kelli Lambrecht - Yea, and Rhonda Lefferd - Yea. Adele Wahwassuck and Joe Mitchell were absent.

Action(s):

Move to adopt resolution 2025-9 which authorizes the district to exceed the revenue neutral rate for the 2025-26 district budget by roll-call vote. This motion, made by Ann Kelly and seconded by Kelli Lambrecht, Carried.

6.3. Conduct 2025-26 District Budget Hearing at 7:20 pm

Also included in this motion is to approve resolution 2025-10 to adopt a 32.6% LOB percentage for the current budget year. This motion, made by Kelli Lambrecht and seconded by Boone Smith, Carried.
