- Another good revenue month and that should continue as we see the increased foundation and salary aid payments. We collected federal funds this month. We collected those about a month later this year. We have collected \$270,000 more this year to date than last year.
- Expenditures are elevated this month with the huge payment for special education services. If you take out that payment, we are spending less monthly than the previous year. Year over year, if you don't have the payment, we will be spending less, which is where we want to be.
- Overall, we continue to be in a good financial position. We are taking in more money monthly than the previous year while our expenses are the same or lower. Minus the big one-time payment.
