1. 2020-21 Budget Discussion

Mr. Best opened the budget discussion by reviewing the final expense summary for the 2019-2020 school year. Final expenditures to finish the year were at 92% of budgeted amounts. Mr. Best reviewed the ending balances in the general fund, activity fund, lunch fund, depreciation fund and the building fund. The anticipated tax asking will be 2.3 % higher than last year. The total tax asking is anticipated to be \$4,021,614. The total proposed levy would be 50.73 cents per \$100 of valuation, an increase of 1.12 cents.








Tax Asking
